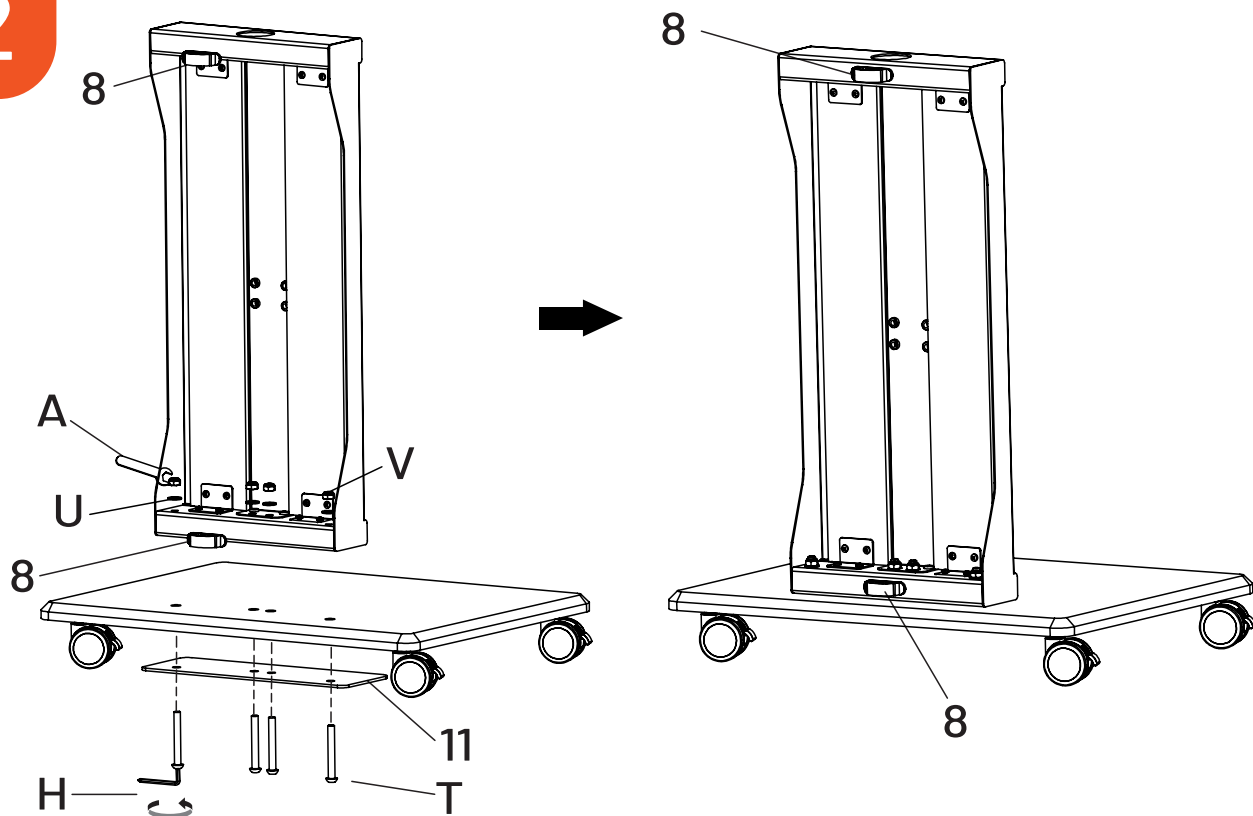


Steps to Install the TV Floor Stand

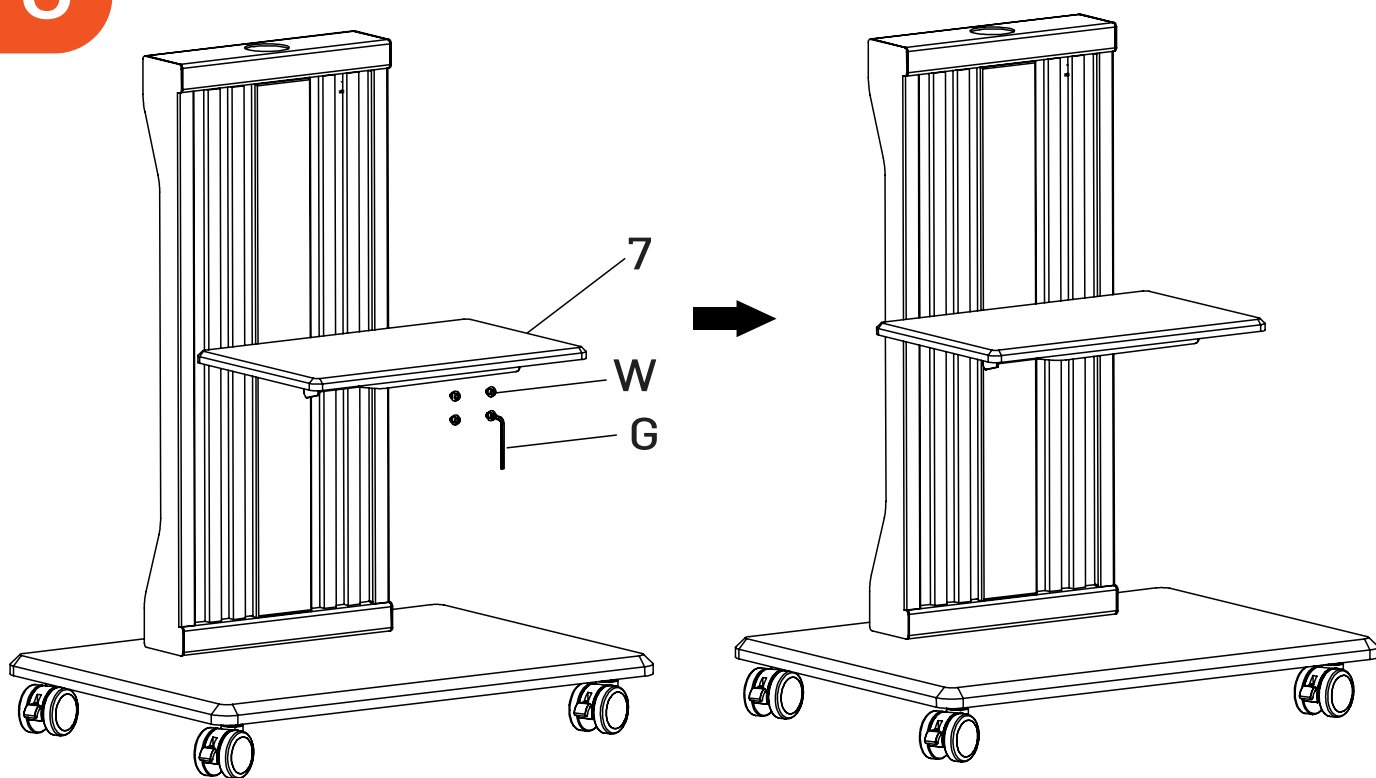
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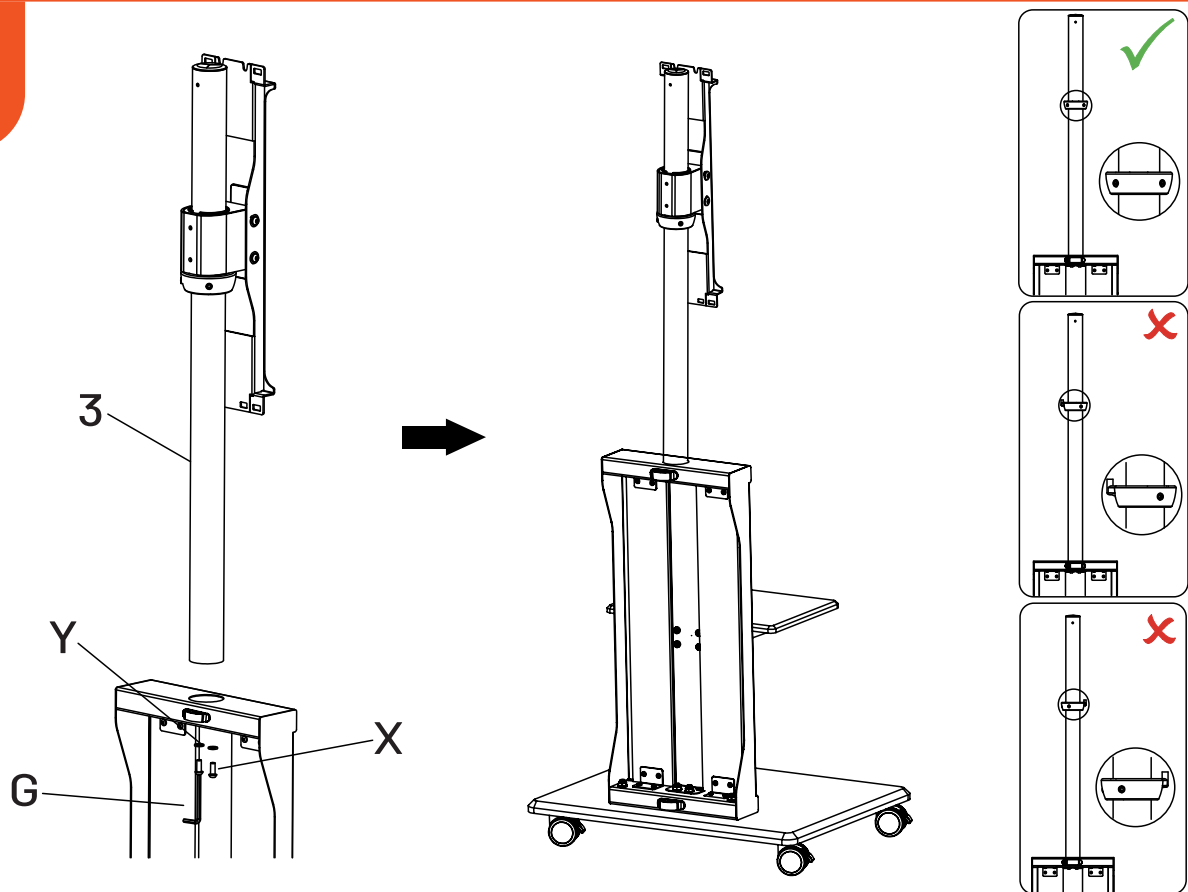
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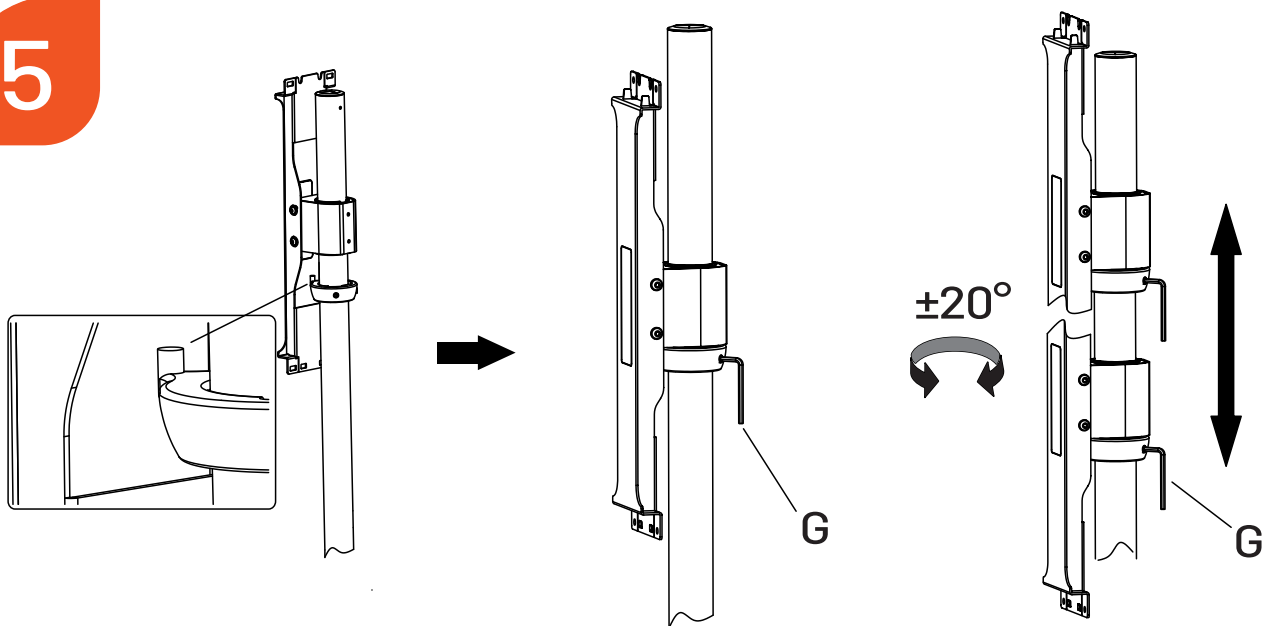

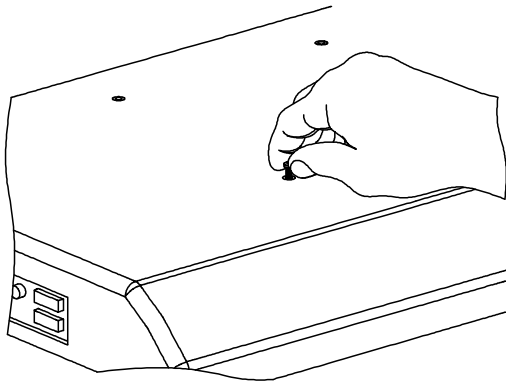
Adjust the limit ring on the front side of the column.

Install the TV panel on the column at a desired height. Lock the limit ring using the G wrench.

Use the G wrench to re-adjust the height of the panel. This assembly allows for $\pm 20^\circ$ changes in the pivot angle of the TV.

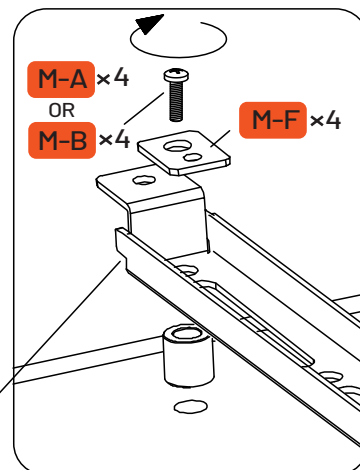
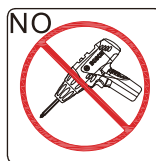
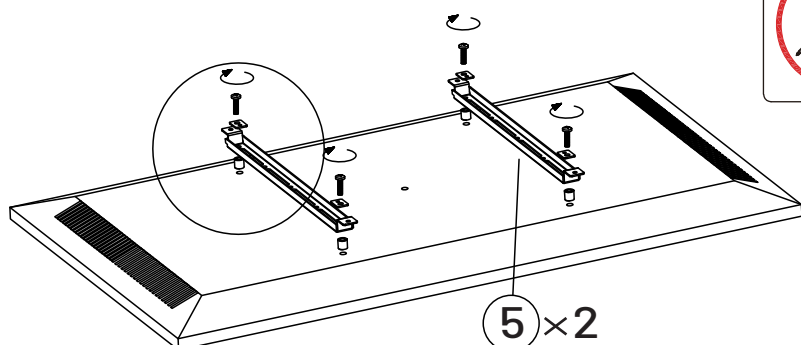
(a) For flat-backed TV



(b) For TV with irregularly shaped back (For instance, curve-backed)

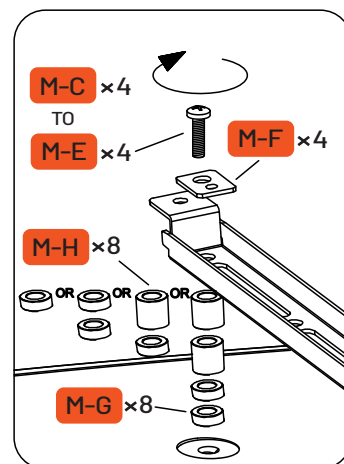
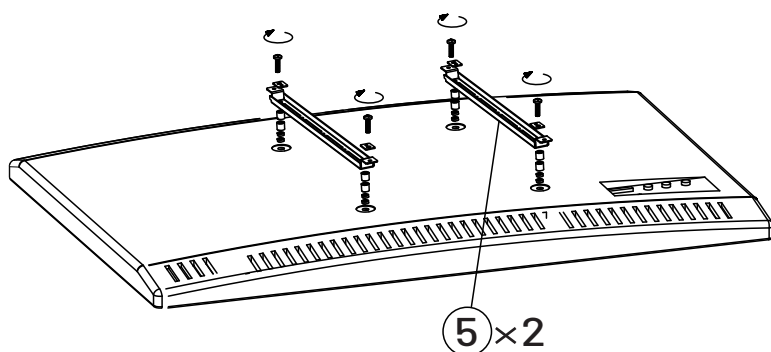


(a1) For Flat Screen TV

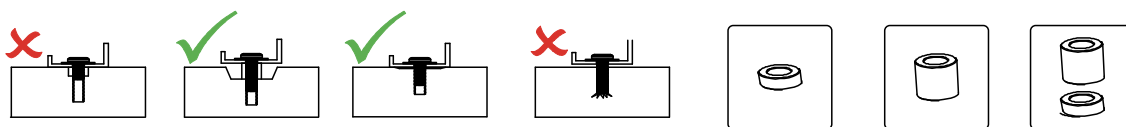

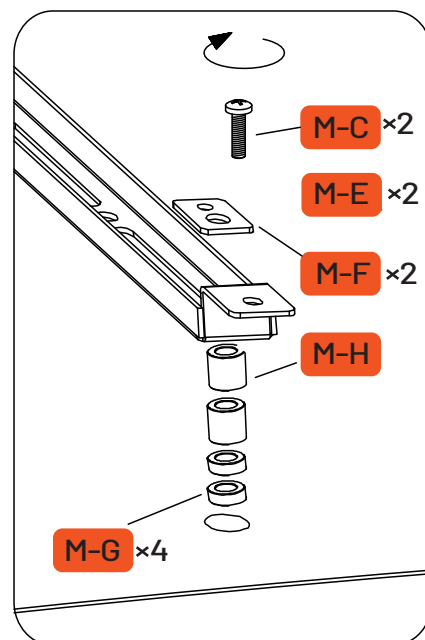
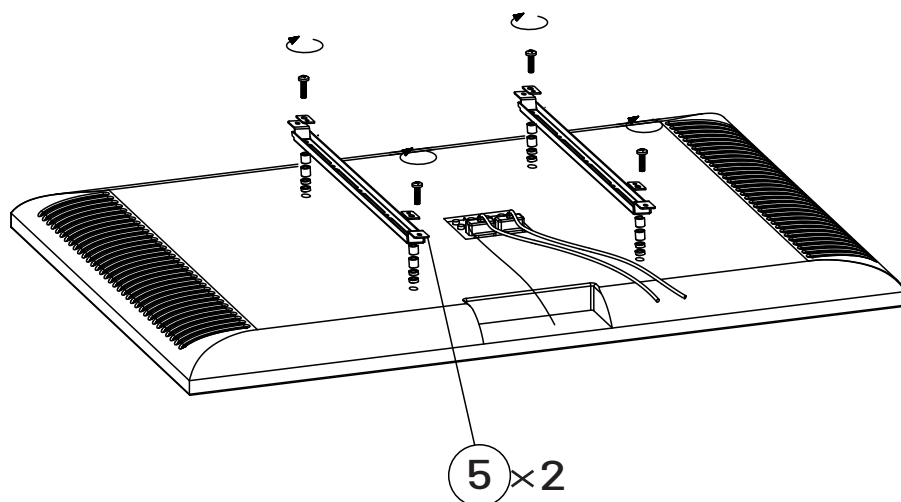


(a3) For Uneven Surface

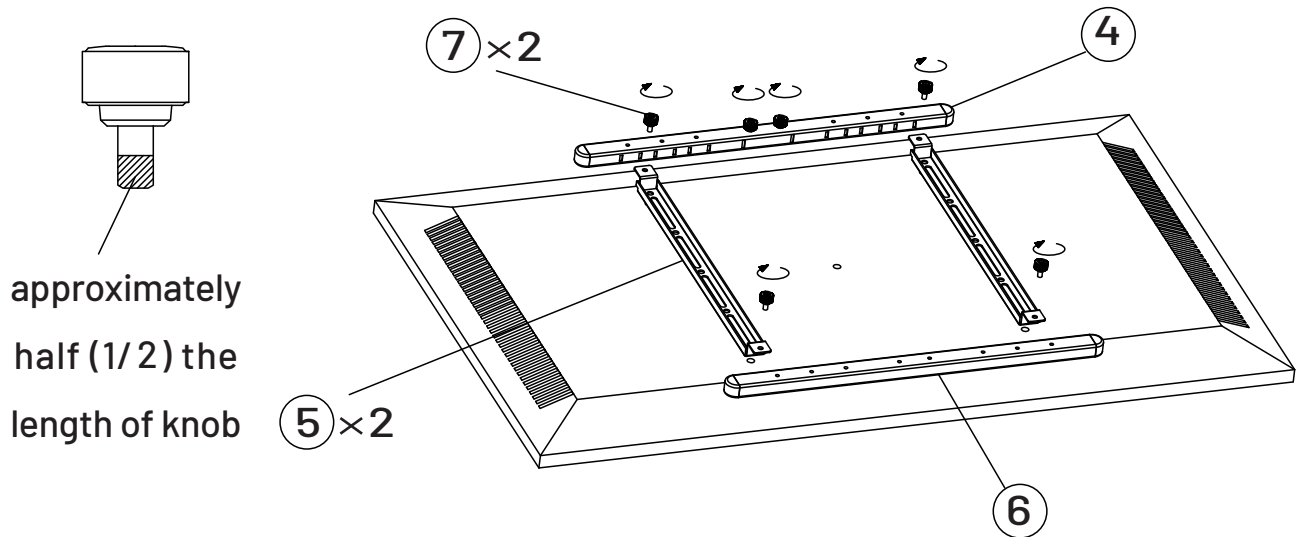
(a4) For TV with Wires In the Middle

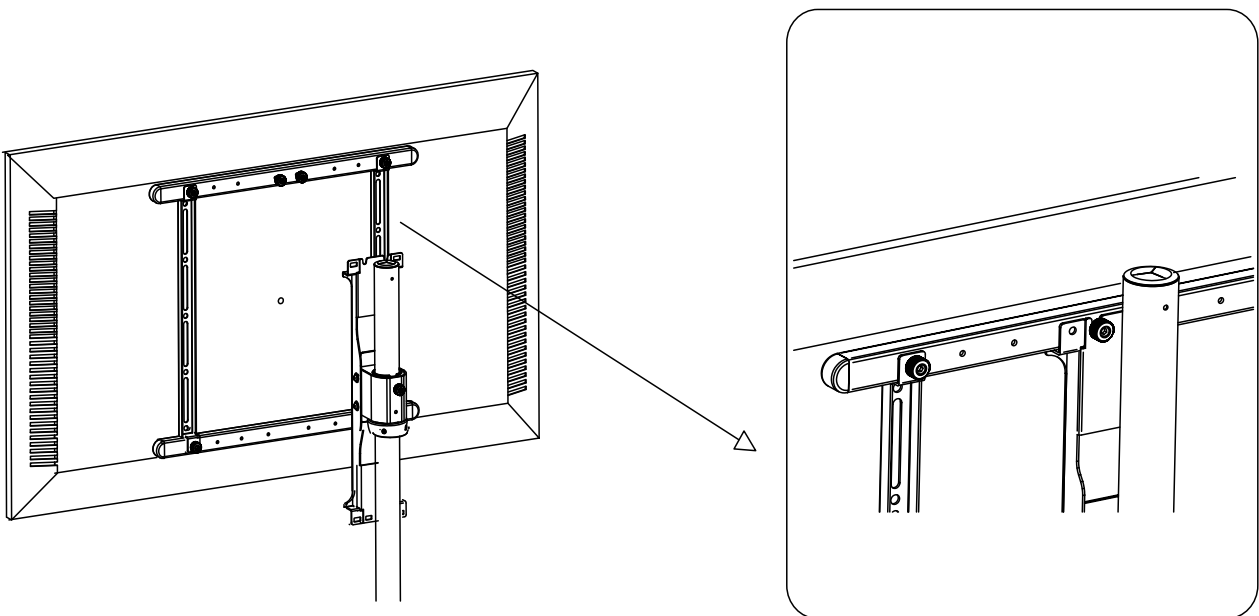

During installation, please ensure that component number 4 is placed at the top of the TV set. Subsequently, rotate the knob to engage the threads until the knob is tightened to approximately half ($1/2$) the length of knob.



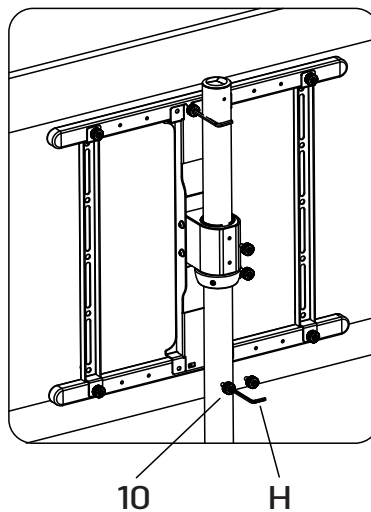
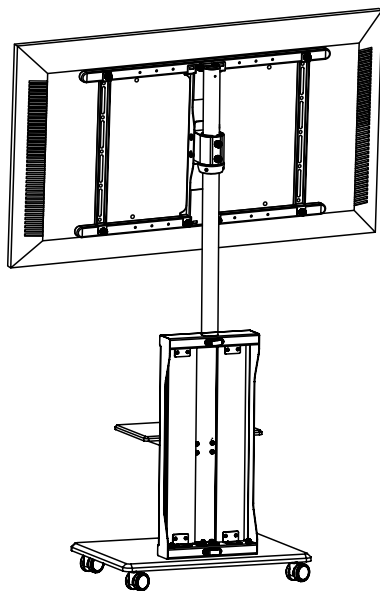

Use the **H** wrench to turn the knob until the thread is screwed to approximately its half ($1/2$) length.

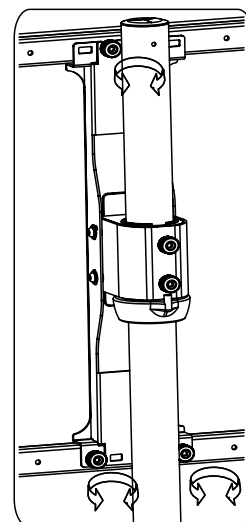
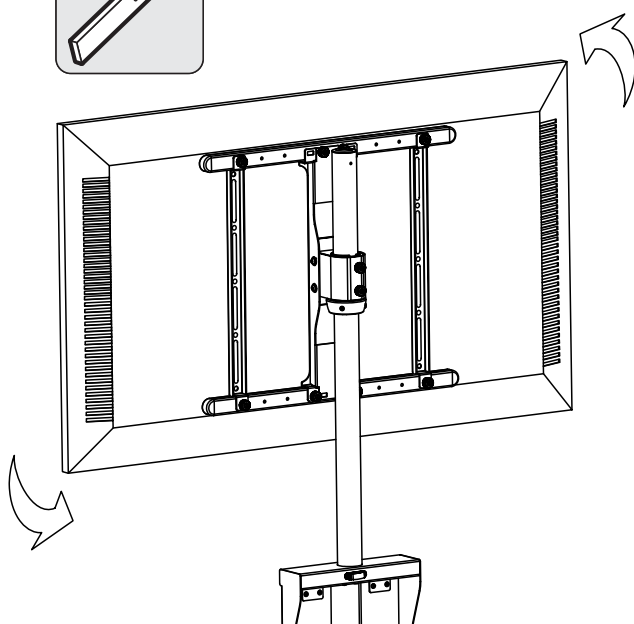
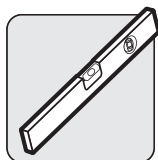

After the TV is installed, use the **H** wrench to turn the knob until all threads are completely screwed and properly fastened.

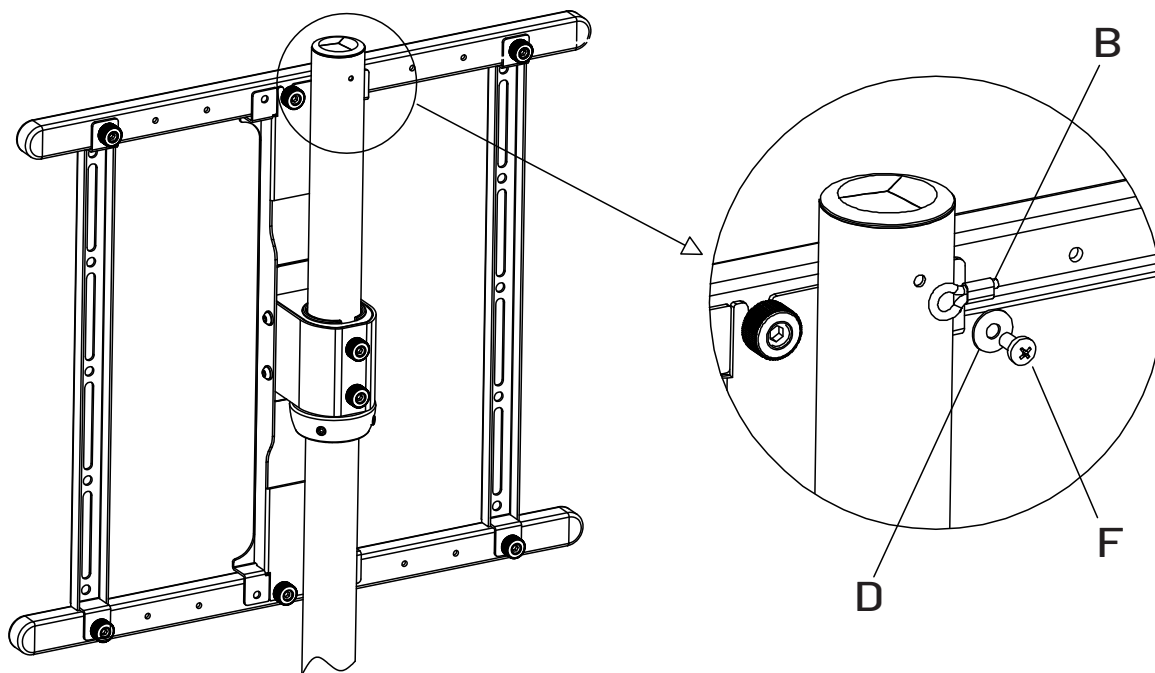

Use the **G** wrench to adjust the screw and set the desired tilt angle of the TV. The range of tilt angle is -5° to $+3^{\circ}$.

3. Secure wall anchors into drilled holes.

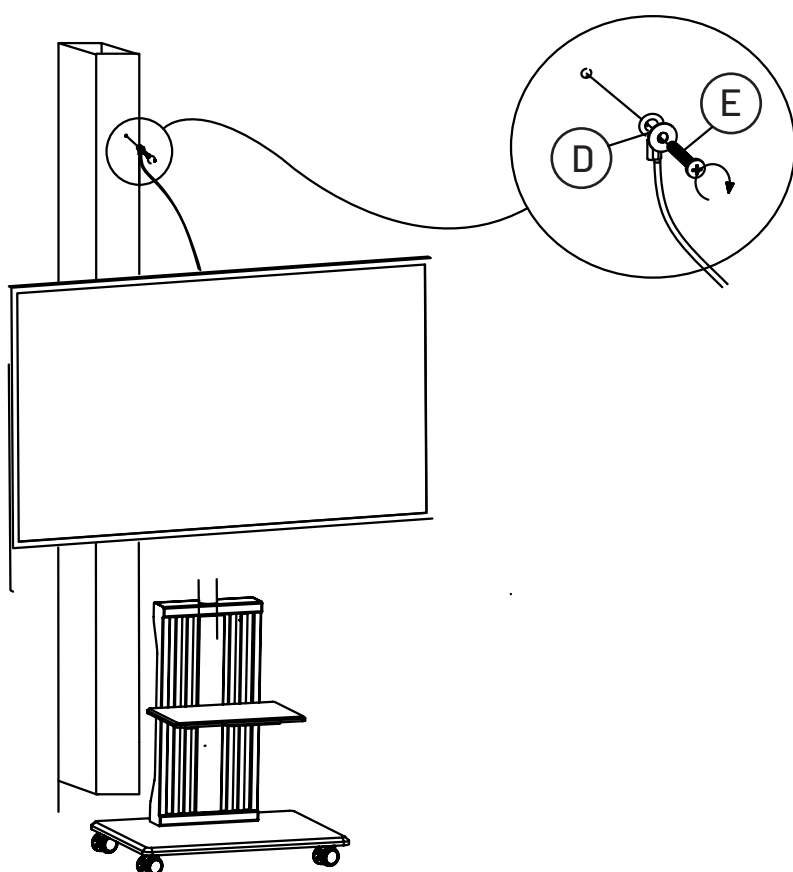
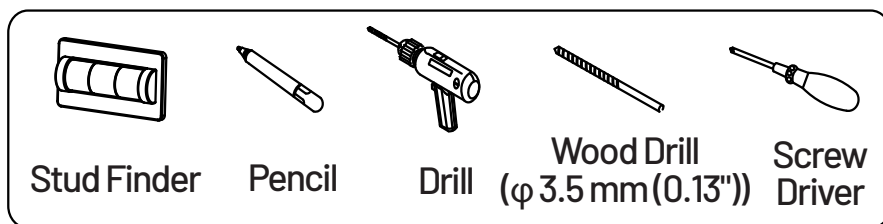

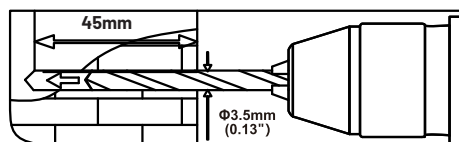
1. Find the exact location to drill the mounting holes using the stud finder.
