

Charging Guideline

- 1. Before using the electric toothbrush, verify that the power supply voltage and the power socket are both functioning properly and within the normal operating range. Confirm that the voltage is compatible with the device to prevent any electrical hazards.
- 2. Before plugging the electric toothbrush into the power supply, ensure that the USB cable is completely dry. Check that the charging plug is free from any water stains, moisture, or physical damage. Only connect the device to the power source if all components are in a safe and proper condition.
- 3. When using the electric toothbrush for the first time, power it on to check for initial functionality. If the battery level is low or if there is no power, fully charge the

toothbrush before its first use. This will ensure optimal performance and longevity of the device.


Notes:

- 1. Always monitor the battery indicator during use to ensure that the toothbrush has sufficient power for effective operation.
- 2. Charge the toothbrush when the battery level is low to maintain optimal performance.
- **3.** If the toothbrush has not been used for a prolonged period, it is recommended to fully charge the device before the next use. This ensures the battery is properly calibrated and helps maintain the health of the battery.
- 4. To ensure the safety of the charging process and enhance the product's lifespan, please follow the charging instructions provided. Proper charging habits contribute to extending the overall service life of the toothbrush.

Electric Toothbrush Guide

- 1. When the power is low and the LED indicator flashes red, please charge your toothbrush. Refer to the charging instructions for details on how to charge it properly.
- 2. Attach the brush head to the handle as shown in the diagram. There should be a slight gap between the brush head and the handle, which is completely normal.

- **3.** Apply a small amount of toothpaste to the bristles. Make sure to use a proper amount that will not cause excessive foam.
- 4. Place the brush head in your mouth, ensuring that the bristles are at a 45° angle to your gums. Turn the toothbrush on by selecting your preferred brushing mode.
- **5.** Move the toothbrush gently up and down, without pressing too hard or scrubbing. Let the toothbrush do the work and avoid vigorous movements for the best results.
- **6.** After turning off the toothbrush, remove it from your mouth to prevent toothpaste foam from splashing. Ensure that you switch the toothbrush off before taking it out.
- 7. After brushing your teeth, rinse the brush head thoroughly with water to remove any toothpaste residue.
- **8.** Place your toothbrush in a well-ventilated and dry area to ensure proper hygiene and prevent any moisture buildup.



Safety Precautions

- 1. Only use toothbrush heads that are recommended by the manufacturer.
- 2. Never expose the product to fire, excessive heat, or high temperatures. Do not charge or use the product in such conditions.
- **3.** For optimal oral health, brush your teeth with your electric toothbrush at least twice a day. Be sure to replace the brush head every 2–3 months to maintain the effectiveness of the brushing action and ensure a thorough clean. Regular replacement of the brush head also helps to prevent the buildup of bacteria, ensuring your brushing experience remains hygienic and efficient.
- 4. The toothbrush contains a built-in rechargeable battery. Handle with care and follow safety guidelines.
- **5.** Keep the charger away from any water sources. Do not place or store it above or near any container with water, such as a bathtub, washbasin, or pool. Do not immerse the charger in water or any other liquid.
- 6. Always use the original charger model for charging to avoid potential hazards.
- 7. Always turn the brush head downward when cleaning it to prevent water from entering the handle.
- 8. After each use, clean the bristles and brush head, and allow them to dry naturally.
- 9. Avoid pulling on the bristles, as this may cause them to deform.
- 10. Dry the toothbrush handle with a dry cloth. Do not soak the toothbrush in water for extended periods. Avoid using water or acidic cleaning liquids above 40°C to clean the toothbrush.

Disposal

- 2. Use a screwdriver to pry off the bottom cover of the toothbrush, exposing the internal components.
- **3.** Gently press down on the motor shaft and carefully remove the internal parts of the device.

4. Use appropriate tools to sever all connecting wires, ensuring the battery is fully detached. Properly dispose of the battery and wires separately as hazardous materials.
