- ⊘ Do not move the product while in operation to prevent accidental injuries.
- ⊘ The power cord and adapter should not be hung on sharp objects or attached to movable items.
- ⊘ Do not place this product on sloped or unstable surfaces. Ensure the product remains horizontal during use, especially in vehicles.
- ⌚ Before using the coffee maker, verify that the power cord is intact and properly connected to the socket.
- ⌚ Always ensure the power is turned off before cleaning or disassembling the product.
- ⚠ Only use attachments or fittings that are provided with the product to prevent fire hazards and personal injury.
- ⚠ Never leave the product unattended while in use.
- ⚠ If the machine is wet, ensure it is thoroughly dried with a cloth before use.
- ⚠ The product is designed for heating water only. Do not use it to heat any other liquids or solids.
- ⚠ Do not exceed 150ml of water when making coffee.
- ⚠ The coffee maker's cup may release high-temperature steam. Please exercise caution when using it.
- ⚠ Although the machine can keep the coffee warm, it is not suitable for use as a travel coffee mug.
- ⚠ When the coffee maker is in dry-boiling protection mode, allow the machine to cool for 5 minutes before using it again.


- ⚠ We recommend using the coffee maker between 14°F and 104°F.
- ⚠ Exercise extra caution when using the coffee maker while driving, especially on bumpy roads, as it may cause the coffee maker to tip over.
- ⚠ After long-term use, scale may form at the bottom of the boiling cup, resembling rust. This is caused by water (not pure water). Please clean it using citric acid.
- ⚠ Do not rinse the boiling cup directly with water or immerse it in water.
- ⚠ This product is not suitable for children or individuals who cannot express themselves clearly.
- ⚠ Do not use or store the coffee maker in the following locations:
Areas with high temperature and humidity, Areas near water, Areas near fireworks, and Locations with strong electromagnetic fields.

Operation Instructions

1. When the power is on, you will hear a "beep" sound, and the digital panel will display "--" with the switch light flashing. This indicates that the machine is in standby mode.
2. Press the button()to start making coffee. The digital panel will display the current temperature. Press the button()again to stop the machine, and the panel will show "--.".
3. The coffee machine operates automatically. When it stops, it will emit 3 "beep" sounds, signaling that the coffee is ready. The brewing time is approximately 10-5 minutes.
4. Fill the heating cup with cold water (figure 1). Note that the water should not exceed the maximum scale.
5. Place the funnel into the heating cup and fill it with ground coffee (do not tamp), as shown in figure 2.
6. Screw the upper cup back on and connect to the power, as shown in figure 3.
7. Press the button()to start brewing coffee. After 10-5 minutes, the coffee will be ready, as shown in figure 4.



Error Code Guide

If you use the coffee machine incorrectly, the digital panel will display error codes.

Error Code: E0

Possible cause: Dry-boiling protection

Solution: The boiling cup is lacking water. Please unplug the power cord and add some water.

Error Code: E1

Possible cause: The input power voltage is low

Solution: Use suitable input power.

Error Code: E2

Possible cause: The input power voltage is high

Solution: Use suitable input power.

Error Code: EE

Possible cause: Temperature sensor fault

Solution: Please contact a service center.

Maintenance

- 1.** Before cleaning and maintaining the product, ensure the power is turned off. Do not rinse the boiling cup directly with water or immerse it in water. Use a soft, damp cloth to clean the surface of the boiling cup.
- 2.** The upper cup and lid can be washed with running water or in a dishwasher.
- 3.** After extended use, scale may form at the bottom of the boiling cup. Clean it with an acid solution using the following steps:

- 3.1** Fill the boiling cup with vinegar or citric acid (about 3/1 of the cup).
- 3.2** Let it sit for 2 to 3 hours, then clean with a soft brush.
- 3.3** Follow this cleaning method regularly, depending on usage.

Troubleshooting

Problem: Power on but not working

Reason: Fuse failure (car power cord)

Solution: Replace the broken fuse with a new one.

Problem: Power on but not working

Reason: The power cable is broken

Solution: Use a new power cable or contact a service center.

Problem: Make less coffee

Reason: Over-tamping the ground coffee

Solution: Do not tamp the ground coffee.

Problem: Make less coffee

Reason: The coffee maker leaks

Solution: Tighten the upper cup and the boiling cup.

Problem: Make less coffee

Reason: The sealing ring is broken

Solution: Replace the sealing ring.

Problem: Coffee maker leaks

Reason: The upper cup and boiling cup didn't screw well

Solution: Tighten the upper cup and the boiling cup.

Problem: Coffee maker leaks

Reason: Too much water added

Solution: Do not exceed 150ml of water.

Disposal
