







#### Package Contents



### Schematic View



#### Caution

- 1. Do not attempt to disassemble or replace any parts of the earbuds.
- 2. Avoid putting the earbuds in water or any other liquid, as they are not waterproof.
- **3.** If any liquid accidentally enters the product, immediately disconnect and remove the connection.
- 4. Ensure your hands are dry when installing or uninstalling the product to prevent the risk of electric shock.
- 5. Keep the product away from heat sources or direct exposure to fire.

**6.** Do not place the product in environments with strong electromagnetic forces, as this may cause malfunctions.

# Charging Guide

Connect the charging bay to a 5V power adapter using the Type-C charging cable. **Note:** If the voltage drops below 3.4V, a low voltage warning will occur every 60 seconds, accompanied by a voice prompt: "Battery low."

## Indicator Light Guide

Power On	The white light flashes.
Power Off	Turn off the light.
Power-on Automatic Pairing	The main headset flashes white.
Pair Left and Right Earphones	The main headset flashes white.
Successful Connection	Turn off the light.
Disconnect	The main headset flashes white.
Earphone Charging	The white light stays on.

#### Instruction for Use

- 1. Power On: Remove the headset from the charging case to turn it on, or press and hold the touch button for 5 seconds to power it on manually.
- 2. Power Off: Place the headset back into the charging case to turn it off, or press and hold the touch button for 5 seconds to manually power it off.
- 3. Pairing and Connecting
- **3.1** Open the charging case and take out the earphones. The left and right earphones will automatically power on.
- **3.2** If the headset was manually powered off, it will enter pairing mode once the Bluetooth on your mobile phone is turned off.
- **3.3** When pairing, select "PD\_STWS\_12" from the Bluetooth list on your phone. Once the pairing is successful, the earphones will announce "TWS Connected" or "TWS Connected Successfully."
- 4. Switch Language Prompt Tone: If the headset is in pairing mode but not

connected to the mobile phone, press the touch button on either earphone four times to switch between English and Chinese voice prompts.

- **5.** Auto Power-Off: If the headset remains in pairing mode without connecting to a device, it will automatically power off after 3 minutes.
- 6. Automatic Reconnection




Connection Successful Voice prompt: "TWS Connected"



- 1. Once the left and right earphones are powered on, they will automatically reconnect.
- 2. After the headset is successfully paired with the mobile phone, it will automatically reconnect to the phone when turned on, as long as the phone's Bluetooth is enabled.


## Touch Function Guide

#### **Voice Assistant**



**Enable Siri:** Press and hold the touch button on either earphone for 3 seconds.

#### **Music Playback**




Play/Pause: Tap the touch button on either earphone.

**Previous Song:** Triple-tap the touch button on either earphone.

**Next Song:** Double-tap the touch button on either earphone.

#### **Call Management**



**Answer an Incoming Call:** Tap the touch button on either earphone.

**Hang Up:** Tap the touch button on either earphone.

**Reject a Call:** Press and hold the touch button on either earphone.
