

Product Overview

Power Button: Press and hold for 3 seconds to turn on the device and prevent accidental operation.

Power Indicator Light: The light is always on while charging and turns off when fully charged.

Reset Button: Insert a card needle into the hole to reset the system in case of a malfunction.

Installation

Before selecting a location for your projector, consider the following factors:

- a. Size and position of your screen
- b. Location of the electrical outlet
- c. Distance between the projector and other equipment Your projector can be installed in the following manner:

1. Front-Desktop

Position the projector near the floor in front of the screen. This is the most common setup for quick installation and portability. Once in place, turn on the projector and configure the following settings:


Settings > Projection Settings > Projection Method > Front-Desktop



2. Front Ceiling

Position the projector suspended from the ceiling in front of the screen. After securing the projector, turn it on and configure the following settings:

Settings > Projection Settings > Projection Method > Front Ceiling




Operation Instructions

1. Starting the projector

1.1 Connect the power cable to both the projector and a power outlet. If applicable, switch on the power outlet. The power indicator light on the projector will turn red once power is supplied. To ensure safety, use only the provided power cable to prevent risks such as electrical shock or fire.

1.2 Press the power button on the projector or the remote control to turn it on. Once the lamp illuminates, the power indicator will turn yellowish-green. The fans will start, and the projector will display a startup image while it warms up. During this warm-up phase, the projector will not respond to additional commands.

2. Adjust the image



Connecting HD devices


1. HD technology supports uncompressed video data transmission between compatible devices, such as laptops, DTV tuners, DVD players, Blu-ray players, and displays, using a single cable. Ensure that an appropriate HD cable is used when establishing a connection.

2. To connect, first connect to the Wi-Fi or set up a hotspot. After connecting to the network, you can stream the video online. The projector and HD devices to be connected include laptops, DVD players, digital tuners, Chromecast, Fire TV, etc.



HD Signal

By connecting an HD cable, you can access various devices such as computers, televisions, set-top boxes, game consoles, and other compatible devices.



Homepage Guide

The homepage displays options such as App Center, Cast, Miracast, Chrome, File Browser, Video, Uninstall, Source, Settings, Apps, and Source. The Source option serves as the entry point for connecting external devices. To download an application, click on "Play Store."



Adding Applications

To view installed programs, click "APP" on the home page. To add a program to the home page, simply click on the program icon.



Settings

This section allows you to manage basic user settings, application management, software versions, network settings, Bluetooth settings, projection settings, language settings, date and time settings, system updates, and other related settings. The "About" section provides additional details about the machine.



Eshare and AirPlay Mirroring

To connect an Android mobile or tablet to the projector via Wi-Fi display technology, follow the instructions below:

- 1. Ensure your Android device is connected to the same network as your projector.
- 2. Once connected, your device will appear in the peer devices list.
- 3. Tap to launch wireless display on your device.
- 4. For iOS devices, make sure your device is connected to the same network as the projector for proper mirroring.





WiFi Settings

Connect to Wi-Fi or set up a hotspot. Once connected, you can stream videos online without interruptions.



Bluetooth Connection

Connect various Bluetooth devices such as phones, Bluetooth speakers, headsets, and more.



Projection Settings

The user can select the installation mode for either front or rear projection. Keystone correction can be adjusted for vertical, horizontal, or four-point trapezoidal alignment. The automatic keystone correction can be toggled on or off. Additionally, the infinite zoom function allows for fine-tuned horizontal and vertical scaling adjustments.



Language Settings

By default, users can select from a range of languages including Chinese, Korean, and more. This version defaults to English.



About This Machine

- 1. View the version number and MAC address information of the device.
- 2. Perform a factory data reset.



Warning

- 1. Use this product only for its intended purpose as outlined in this manual.
- 2. Avoid looking directly into the lens while the projector is operating.
- **3.** Do not block the ventilation holes of the projector with cloth or any other material.
