Compatibility

This selfie stick is compatible with both iOS and Android devices, allowing seamless use across a wide range of smartphones.

Instructions for Use

- 1. Power On: Press and hold the camera button for 3 seconds to turn on the device. The indicator light will flash to signal that it is in pairing mode.
- 2. Bluetooth Pairing: Open Bluetooth settings on your mobile device, search for "VIP," and select it to connect. Once paired, the indicator light will turn off.
- **3.** Taking Photos: After the remote is connected, press the camera button to capture a photo. The indicator light will flash, signaling that the photo has been taken.
- 4. Automatic Power Off (No Connection): If the remote is not connected and remains idle, it will automatically power off after approximately 5 minutes.
- **5.** Automatic Power Off (Connected): When connected to a mobile phone, the remote will enter sleep mode after 10 minutes of inactivity and will automatically turn off after an additional 10 minutes.
- **6.** Sleep Mode: To reconnect the remote after it enters sleep mode, simply press the camera button to restore the connection to your mobile phone.
- 7. Turning Off the Device: In both active and sleep modes, press and hold the camera button for 3 seconds to turn off the indicator and power off the device.
- **8.** Auto Reconnect: The remote has a memory function that will automatically reconnect to the last paired device once Bluetooth is activated on your phone.

Remote Control Guide

Remove the Remote Control: Slide the remote control out from either the left or right side (see Figure 1).

Rechargeable Battery: The remote control features a rechargeable battery with a Micro-USB interface. You can charge it using a USB adapter or a power bank (see Figure 2).





Flexible Clip Rotation

The clip can rotate freely, allowing you to shoot both horizontally and vertically. This feature lets you capture photos from multiple angles, offering more versatility.



Switch to Tripod Mode

To switch to tripod mode, open the handle outward to extend the legs.



When switching to tripod mode, ensure that you pull out the final section of the lever and adjust it until the tripod is stable.

Bluetooth Connection

- 1. Turn on the Bluetooth on your mobile phone and remove any previously paired devices.
- 2. Restart your mobile phone.

- 3. Restart the Bluetooth remote control.
- 4. Re-enable Bluetooth on both the mobile phone and remote control.
- 5. On your mobile phone, turn on Bluetooth.
- 6. Turn on the remote control and search for the mobile phone.
- 7. Once you see "VIP" in the search results, click "Connect."
- 8. The interface will display "connecting." If needed, press the remote control button continuously until the connection is established.
- 9. This process is required only for the initial connection; subsequent connections will be automatic.

Remote Control and Android Devices

- 1. For Android phones, use the remote control to resolve issues with focus adjustment, quantity settings, or unresponsiveness.
- 2. Open the camera app to access the photography interface.
- 3. Swipe left or right to access the camera settings.
- 4. Select the volume key function.
- 5. Set the volume key to function as the shutter (do not select zoom or focus options).
- 6. The settings path may vary based on your mobile camera app. Please refer to your camera's settings.

Note: This remote control supports the video recording function of the mobile camera, but it does not support video recording within live streaming apps.

Operating Modes

- 1. Remote Control: Effective range of 10 meters.
- 2. Tripod Mode
- 3. Handheld Mode

General Operation Guide

- 1. Connect the Bluetooth remote control to the mobile phone.
- 2. Open the camera app on your mobile phone or download a third-party camera app.
- 3. Switch to video mode in the camera interface.
- 4. Press the remote control button to start recording.
- 5. Press the button again to stop recording.

Usage status: The blue light flashes when the device is in use and turns off after the connection is established. You can also take pictures, and the light will flash when the photo is taken.

Charging status: The red light indicates charging; it will remain on until the device is fully charged, then turn off.

Disposal
