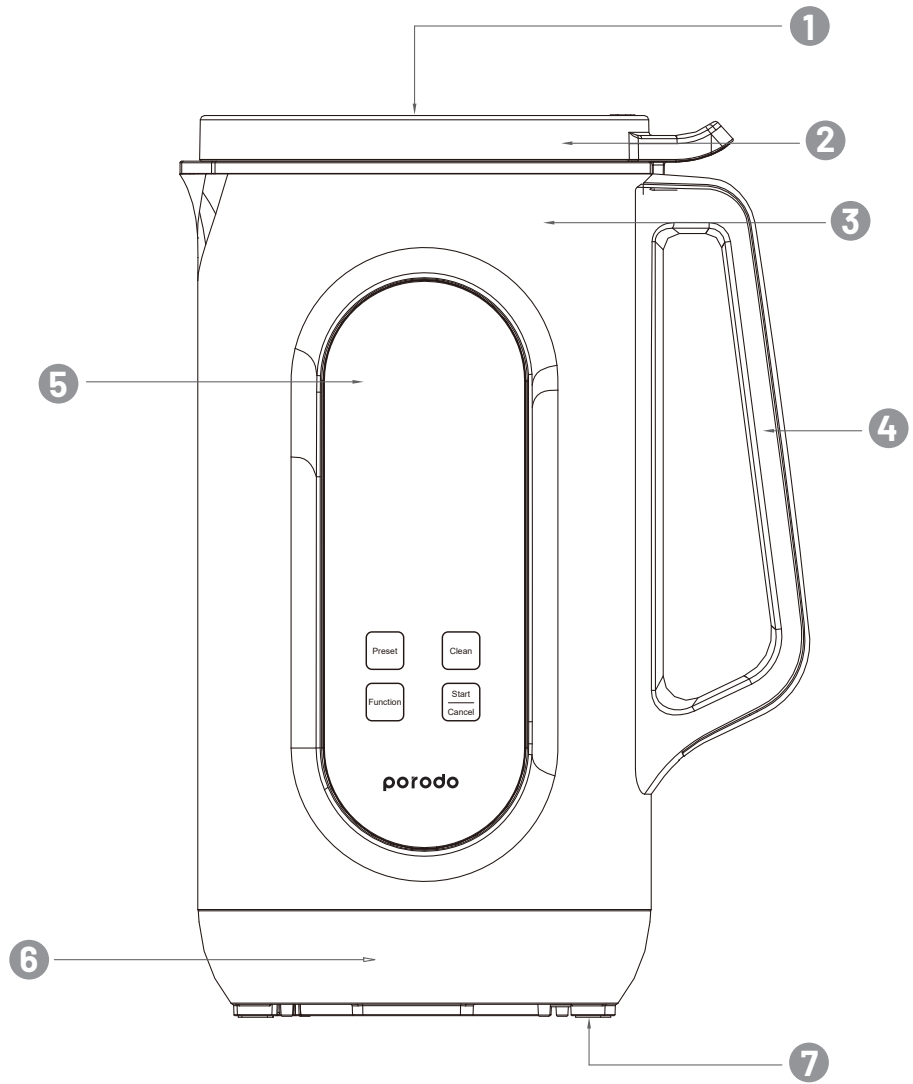

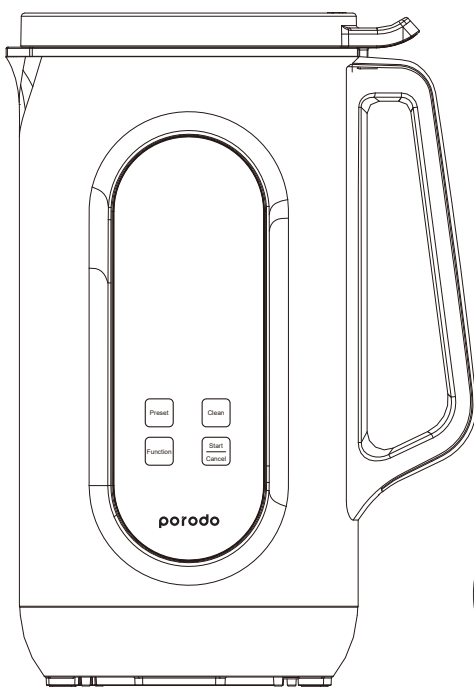

Schematic View

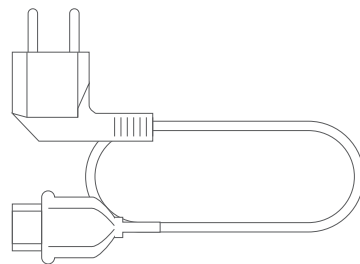
- 1. Transparent Lid

- 7. Non-Slip Base



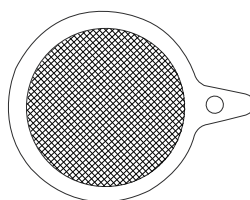

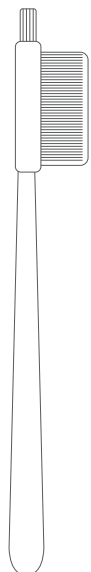

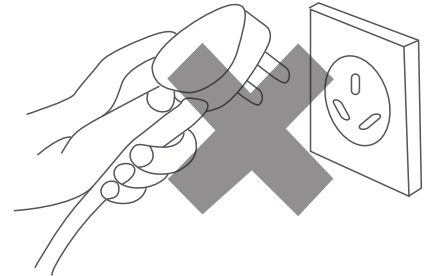

Safety Precautions

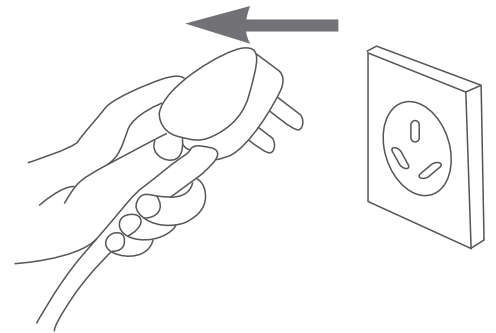
 Use the appliance only for its intended use. Otherwise, the product may be damaged or it will pose a risk to personal safety.



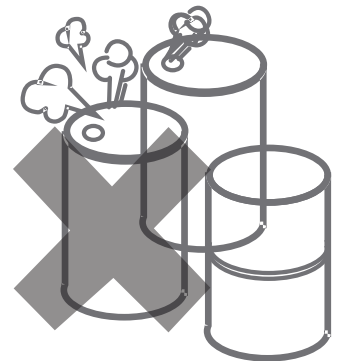
1. This appliance is intended for household use only.

4. Keep the appliance out of reach of children, infants, and pets. Never leave the operating appliance unattended.



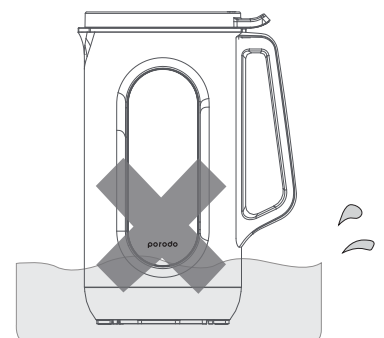
5. Always unplug the appliance before cleaning.

7. Do not use the appliance near flammable or explosive materials, and avoid placing it near heat sources (e.g., ovens).



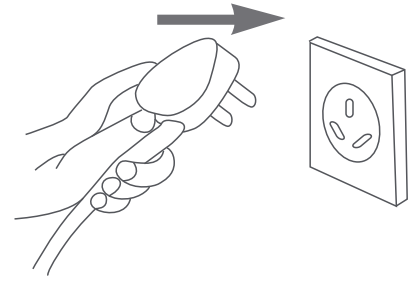
8. Do not use or store the appliance in areas with high humidity.
9. Do not immerse the appliance in water.





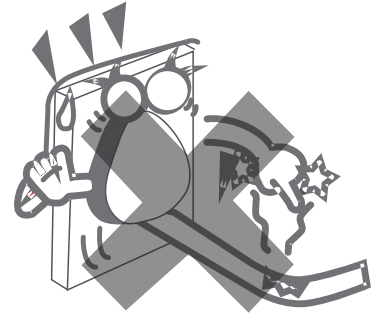
10. Ensure the power cord is properly plugged in before use.

11. Check that the plug is securely connected and not loose.



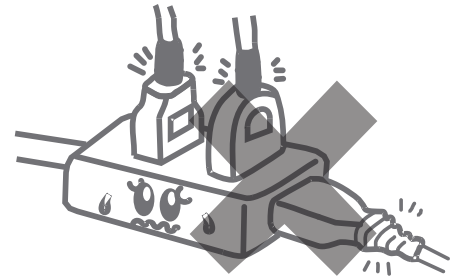
12. Do not use damaged power cords or plugs.

13. Do not operate the appliance when the power cord is bundled. Avoid damaging, modifying, or pulling the power cord.



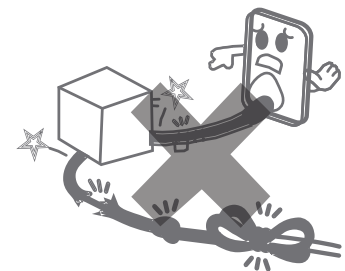
14. Avoid using extension cords that may cause overheating of the socket.

15. Do not place heavy objects on the power cord or apply pressure.



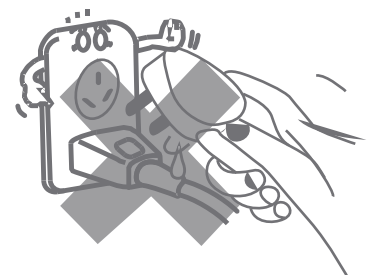
16. If the power cord is damaged, contact a professional technician for repairs.

18. Never unplug the power cord with wet hands.

19. The plug should not be cleaned with a wet cloth.





20. Do not touch the main unit or the jar lid while the appliance is in operation.

21. Exercise caution, as hot water or steam may spill after the liquid in the cup begins to boil. Do not open the lid of the cup.

22. This appliance is not suitable for use by individuals including children with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, unless supervised or instructed by a responsible person.

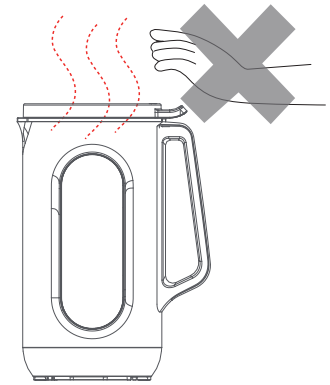
23. Do not place the appliance in the cabinet while in operation.

25. Do not use the appliance outdoors.




Instructions for Use



 	<p>After plugging in the power cord, the indicator light on the operation panel will illuminate, emitting a "beep" sound, and "—" will appear on the LED screen. Press the "Start/Cancel" button to display 8 icons and enter the function selection mode.</p>
	<p>Press the "Function" button to select a function (Soy Milk / Solid Foods / Rice Cereal / Porridge / Corn Juice / Fresh Juice / Boil / Warm). The indicator lights for the selected function will flash, while the indicator lights for the other functions will remain illuminated.</p>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. After selecting the function, press the "Start/Cancel" button to begin cooking. 2. If you press the "Start/Cancel" button while the product is running, the cooking process will stop and the appliance will return to standby mode.
 ↓  ↓ 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Press the "Preset" button, then press the "Function" button to select the desired cooking mode, and finally press the "Start" button to set the reservation. 2. The indicator light for the selected function will remain on, and the LED screen will display the set time, beginning the countdown to confirm the successful reservation. 3. Press the "Preset" button to select the countdown time. Each time you press the "Preset" button, the time will accumulate (1H/ 2H/... 11H/12H), with a maximum reservation time of 12 hours.
	<p>Press the "Clean" button, then press the "Start/Cancel" button to enter cleaning mode. Once cleaning is complete, the appliance will automatically return to standby mode.</p> <p>Warning: Do not add highly corrosive cleaning agents to the jar.</p>

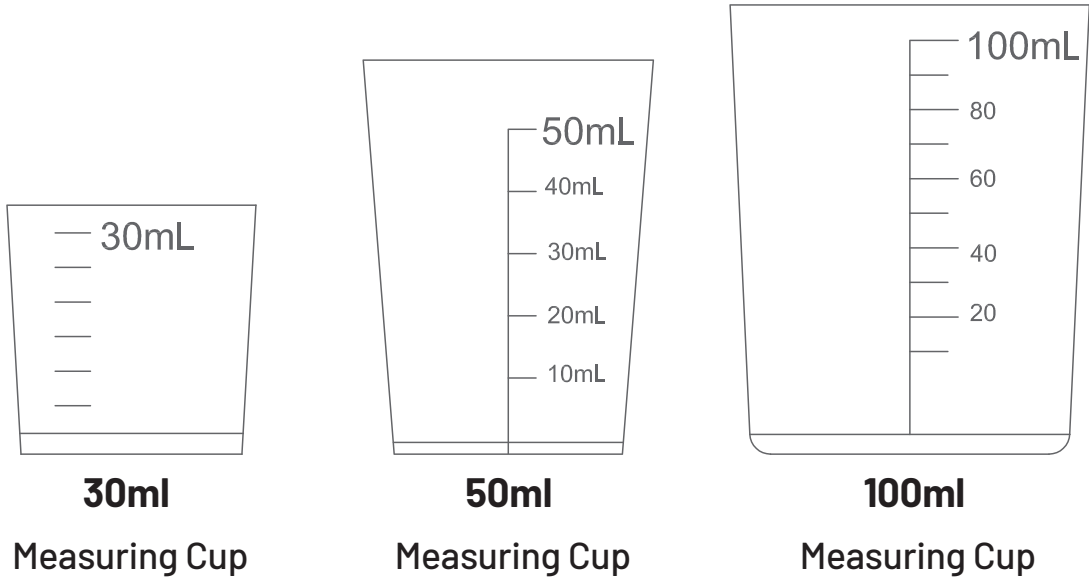
Adjust the amount of ingredients based on actual needs or personal preference.

Food Type	Instructions	Ingredients	Precautions
Soy Milk	Place 70g of soybeans into the mixing cup, then add water up to the "maximum" water level.	Soy Bean	1. Adding excessive water or soybeans may cause overflow and affect the taste. 2. Do not open the lid to add ingredients while the product is operating to avoid the risk of burns.
Solid Food	Place 50g of ingredients into the mixing cup, then add water up to the "maximum" water level.	Rice, millet, pumpkin, lotus seeds, etc.	Do not add too many ingredients, as it may cause overflow and affect the taste.
Rice Cereal	Place 70g of rice into the mixing cup, then add water up to the "maximum" water level.	Rice paste, millet paste, pumpkin paste, etc.	
Porridge	Place 100g of rice into the mixing cup, then add water up to the "maximum" water level.	Rice, millet, cooked peanuts	
Corn Juice	Place 150g of ingredients into the mixing cup, then add water up to the "maximum" water level.	Corn Kernels	—
Fresh Juice	Do not add more than 300g of fruit, and ensure that the pieces are no larger than 3cm. Add water until it just covers the ingredients, ensuring the water level does not exceed the "maximum" scale line.	Watermelon, Apple, Pineapple, Mango, Lemon, Grape, Banana, Strawberry, Honeydew	1. If the water level does not exceed the fruit, it will affect the blending effect. 2. Never exceed the maximum water level.

Wash the soybeans, add all ingredients into the mixing bowl, and press the "Soy Milk" function to start.

Steps

Wash the pumpkin and rice, cut the pumpkin into small pieces, add all the ingredients, and press the "Rice Cereal" function to start.

Wash the rice, add all the ingredients, and press the "Porridge" function to start.

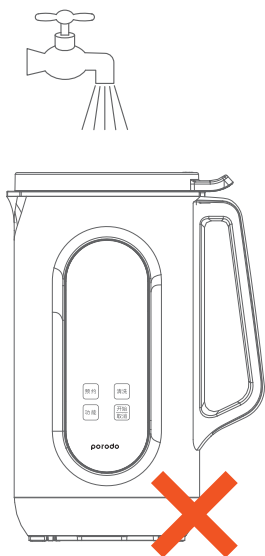

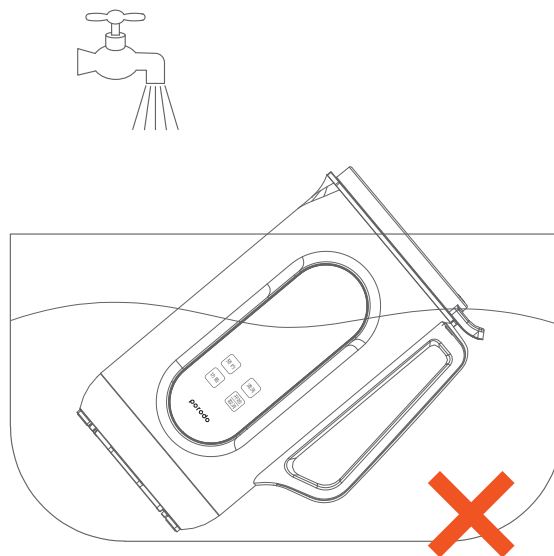
Wash the apple and cut into small pieces, add all the ingredients, and press the "Fresh Juice" function to start.

Cleaning and Maintenance



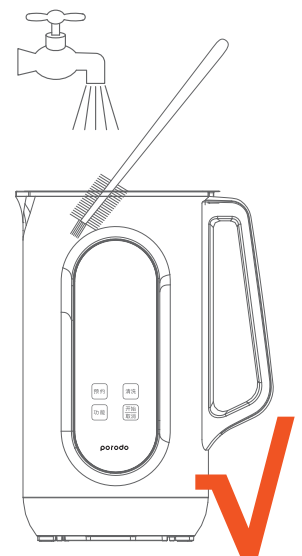
A. Incorrect Method

The main unit cannot be washed with water.



B. Incorrect Method

The main unit cannot be immersed in water.



C. Correct Method

The inner parts and blades can be cleaned with a cleaning brush.

1. Remove the power cord from the machine, unplug it from the power supply, and wait for it to cool before cleaning.
2. The appliance socket must be wiped dry before the appliance is used again.
3. The main unit must not be immersed in water or any liquid for cleaning.
4. Do not use highly corrosive detergents for cleaning, and avoid using a wire brush to clean the inner parts.
5. Due to the water quality, water will naturally produce a mixture of calcium carbonate and magnesium carbonate during the heating process. Heavier

sediments can form scale at the bottom of the jar. Scale can increase the time needed to boil water and increase the noise when boiling. To clean scale, use edible vinegar (mix water and vinegar in a 2:1 ratio, boil it, and leave overnight. The next day, pour out the water, rinse with clean water, boil again, and then discard).

6. The inner parts and blades can be cleaned with a brush (Figure C).

Note: For first use, fill the machine with water to the highest water level, boil it, pour out, and rinse with clean water. Repeat once or twice to remove any dust that may have accumulated during production and storage.

7. The blades in the jar are very sharp and cannot be removed. Handle with care during cleaning. Never remove the blade yourself or touch any moving parts.

8. This product uses a high-speed motor, so intermittent sounds during crushing are normal.

Troubleshooting

Problem and Error Code	Description	Solution
The indicator light does not turn on.	The power cord is not plugged in properly.	Plug in the power cord properly.
Function buttons do not work.	The jar lid is not aligned with the indicator line.	Close the cup lid as required and align with the indication mark.
The machine does not operate.	No function has been selected. Machine failure.	Select the corresponding function. Contact a service center and send it for repair.
E1	NTC short circuit.	Contact a service center and send it for repair.
E2	The jar lid is not closed, or the indicator mark is not aligned.	Close the cup lid as required and align with the indication mark.
E3	Machine dry burning, high-temperature fault code.	Cut off the power and turn off the device.
The ingredients does not get chopped and mixed.	Wrong function selected. Too few or too many ingredients. Machine failure.	Select the appropriate function. Add ingredients according to the recipe instructions. Contact a service center and send it for repair.

- 1.** Add water up to the water level mark (no ingredients needed).
 - 2.** After powering on and in standby mode, press the "Start/Cancel" button for 3 seconds. When the digital display shows "hh," press the "Start/Cancel" button again to enter the water boiling program.

3. Once the water boiling process is complete, the intelligent altitude recognition will be finished, and the product will be ready for use.
