


Schematic View



Purification and Filtration Guide

- 1. The activated carbon filter effectively absorbs contaminants to reduce chlorine, organic chemicals bad odors, and unpleasant tastes.
- 2. The membrane microfilter features hollow fiber membranes with microscopic 0.01-micron pores to trap bacteria, parasites and microplastics.
- **3.** Dirty water enters, while safe, filtered water passes through.

Note: The filter can be used separately by detaching it from the cap.



It is ideal for outdoor activities such as hiking or camping. Please ensure the cap is placed back on the filter after use to keep it clean.

Tips for Using the Filter

- 1. When taking the filter for outdoor hiking or camping, always place the cap on it to keep it clean.
- 2. To use, fill the bottle with water and sip through the straw 8 to 10 times to obtain fresh water.

Note: It requires more suction than standard bottles because the water is filtered through the membrane microfilter and activated carbon filter.

- **3.** The filter is capable of processing up to 132 gallons (500 liters) of "dirty" water.
- 4. The filter will stop functioning when it reaches the end of its lifespan. If you can no longer sip water through the straw, it is time to replace the filter.
- 5. Rinse the filters with water only. Do not use soap to clean the filters.
- 6. Never allow the Membrane Microfilter to freeze after it has been used. If it freezes, it must be replaced.
- 7. If the product is dropped, check that the filter is still securely connected to the cap. Replace the filter if the housing is cracked or damaged.
- 8. Avoid using or exposing the product to extreme heat (above 140°F/60°C) or freezing temperatures (below 32°F/0°C).
- 9. After cleaning, wipe the parts with a dry cloth and allow them to air dry in a cool place.
- 10. If you plan to store your filter bottle for more than one month without use, ensure it is dry and store the filter properly.

Instructions for Use

[A] Preparation Before First Use

- 1. Remove the filter and wash the bottle and cap using a mild detergent.
- 2. Rinse the filter under tap water for 60 seconds, then reattach it to the cap.
- **3.** Fill the bottle with water, screw the filter onto the cap to ensure it is submerged, and soak it for 10 minutes.

4. Take a few quick, strong sips to initiate the water flow.

Note: The initial sips may have a slower flow rate as air is displaced from the filter. Flow should improve after the first few drinks.

[B] Daily Use

- 1. Unscrew the cap and fill the bottle with water.
- 2. Ensure the filter is properly secured to the cap, then screw the cap back onto the bottle.
- 3. Sip and enjoy safe, filtered water.

Note: Always keep the filter away from contaminated water to maintain its effectiveness.
