Safety Instructions


- 1. Avoid using headphones at high volume levels to prevent potential hearing loss caused by prolonged noise exposure.
- 2. If you are in an unsafe or potentially hazardous situation, stop using the headphones to ensure your safety.
- **3.** Use headphones responsibly by moderating both the volume and the duration of usage.
- 4. Keep the volume at a reasonable level to remain aware of your surroundings. If the volume is too high and causes tinnitus or discomfort, lower it immediately.
- **5.** It is not recommended to listen to music while driving, as it may distract you from road safety.
- 6. Clean the headphones with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid exposing them to water, as this can cause permanent damage.
- 7. If you experience discomfort, irritation, or any adverse reactions while using the headphones, discontinue use immediately.
- **8.** Store and use the headphones in a temperature range between -15°C (5°F) and 55°C (131°F). Extreme temperatures may damage the headphones or reduce their battery life.

Battery Safety Warning

- 1. Use the original charging cable to charge the headset. Using an incompatible charging cable may damage the battery or the headset.
- 2. The headset is equipped with a built-in rechargeable battery. Do not attempt to remove the battery, as this may result in damage to the device.
- 3. Keep the battery away from high temperatures, such as direct sunlight, open flames, or other sources of overheating, to prevent damage or safety risks.
- 4. Always use the correct type of battery when replacing it. Improper battery replacement may lead to a risk of explosion.
- 5. Use a power adapter with an output of 5V/1A for charging. Using a high-voltage adapter may cause the device to overheat or become damaged.




Power On/Off

Power On: Slide the switch to the "ON" position.
 A voice prompt will announce "Power on."
 A blue light will illuminate to confirm activation.
 The device will vibrate once for additional confirmation.




2. Power Off: Slide the switch to the "OFF" position.

A voice prompt will announce "Power off."



Connecting with One Phone

1. Activate Pairing Mode: Switch the headphones to the "ON" position to enter auto-pairing mode.


2. The blue and red lights will flash alternately, indicating the headphones are ready to pair.


- 3. A voice prompt will announce, "Ready to pair."
- 4. Turn on Bluetooth on your mobile device.
- **5.** Connect to the headphone by searching the device name "PD-STWLEP033" in the list of available Bluetooth devices on your mobile phone and select it to connect.
- 6. A voice prompt will announce, "Device connected," to confirm successful pairing.

Note: After pairing successfully, the device will automatically reconnect the next time it is used. If the connection fails, the headset will automatically re-enter pairing mode. In such cases, please manually pair the device by following the provided instructions.

Connecting with Two Phones

1. Turn off Bluetooth on both the mobile device and the headset.






Disable Bluetooth connection on the phone.


Turn off the headset.

2. Turn on Bluetooth on the second mobile phone and select "PD-STWLEP033"

from the list of available devices to connect.








Turn on the headset.

Choose PD-STWLEP033 to connect.


3. Reactivate Bluetooth on the first mobile phone and connect to "PD-STWLEP033" again to establish a dual connection.

Call Management

Answer/End Call

Single-press

Single-press the button once to answer an incoming call or to hang up an ongoing call.

Reject Call

Double-press

Double-press the o button to reject an incoming call.

Switch Calls

Double-press

Double-press the button to toggle between calls on your mobile phone and the headset.




Double-press

Double-press the button to activate Siri or another voice assistant set up on your device.

Factory Reset

While the device is charging, press and hold the button. The red and blue light flashes twice to signal that the reset operation is complete.



Charging Instructions

Use the charging cable to attach the headset to a power source. The red indicator light will turn off once the device is fully charged.

Note: The headset cannot be powered on during the charging process.

Battery Warning

- 1. Avoid disassembling, bumping, crushing, or exposing the battery to fire.
- 2. Discontinue use immediately if the battery exhibits severe swelling.
- 3. Do not store or operate the battery in high-temperature environments.



Retracting the Wire


[A] Correct Method

To extend the lifespan of the headset, gently retract the wire by following these steps:

- 1. Hold the wire securely with your hands.
- 2. Press the Earbud Retract Button to begin retracting the earbuds into your hands.




- 3. Release your grip on the wire while maintaining a relaxed curve in your fingers.
- 4. Press the Earbud Retract Button again to allow the remaining wire to fully retract into the headset.



[B] Incorrect Method

Avoid pressing the Earbud Retract Button directly without holding the wire. Doing so may cause the earbuds to retract forcefully, potentially damaging the headset.
