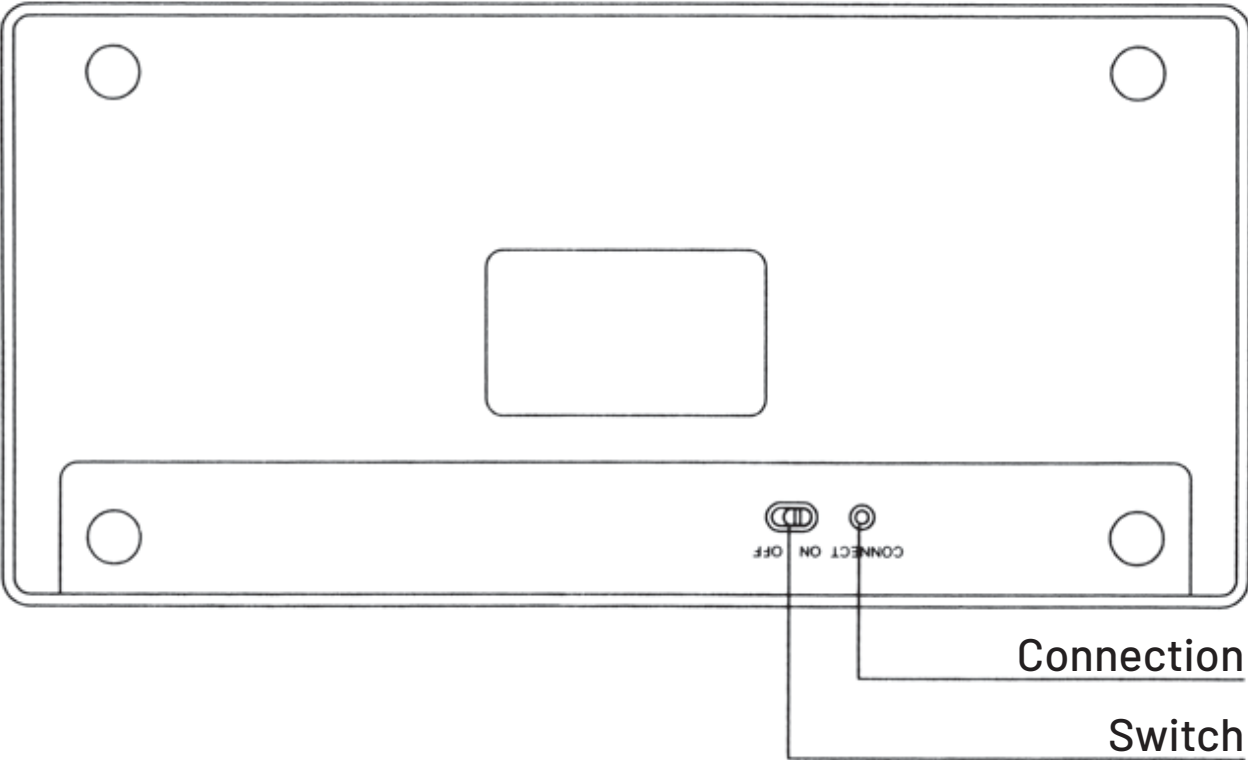

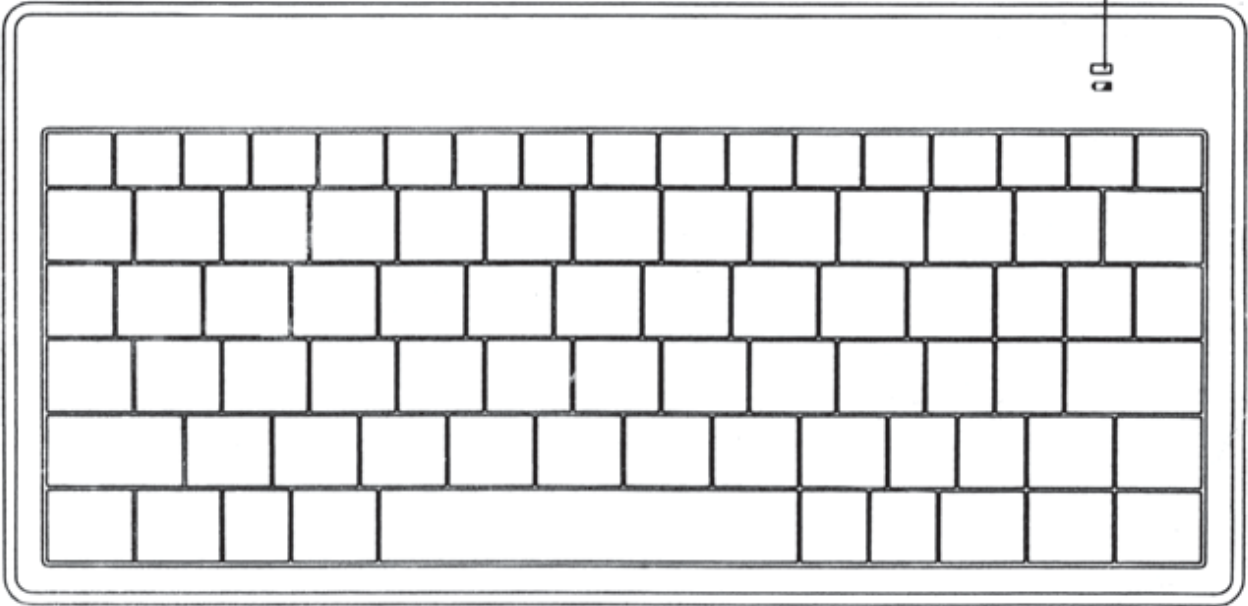

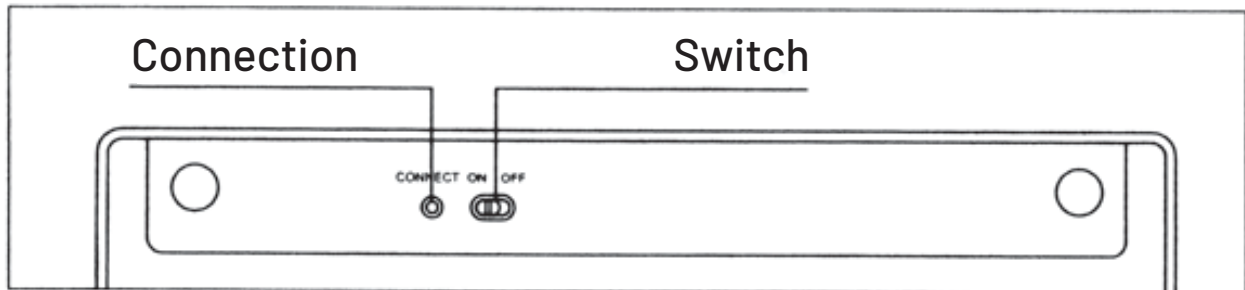


Low Voltage Indicator  
Connection Indicator



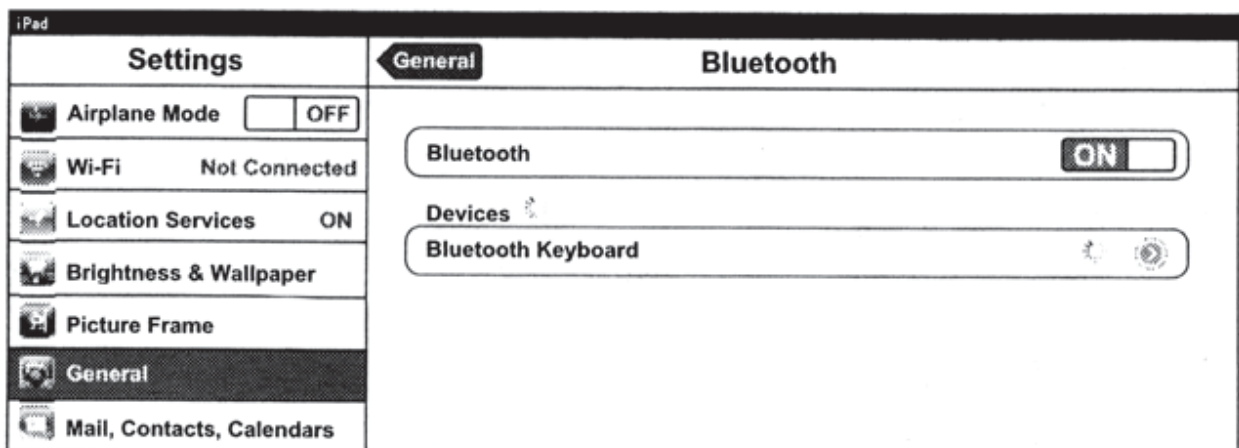
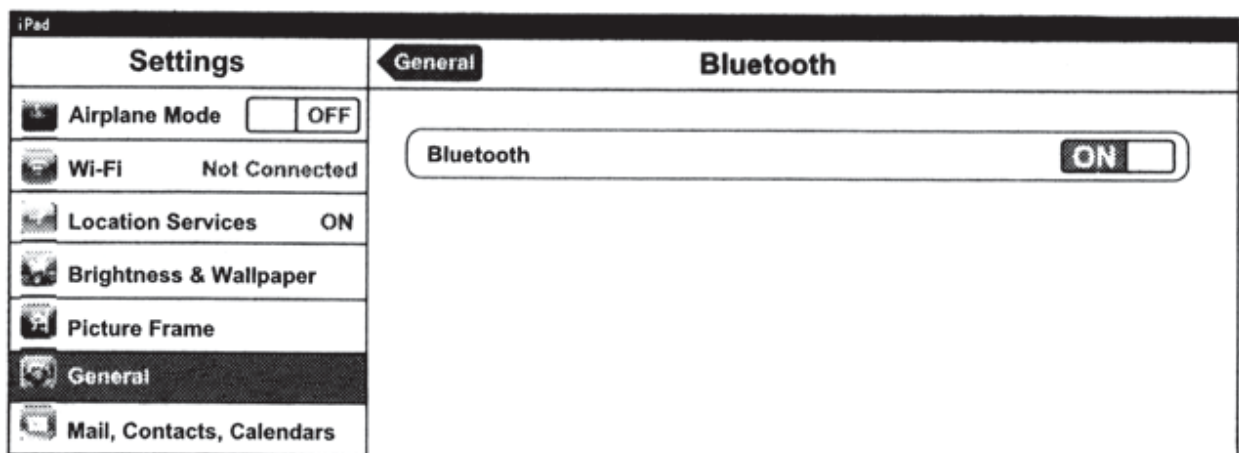
## Connecting to Mac Systems

1. Switch on the keyboard.
2. Press the Connect button. The blue LED will flash, indicating that Bluetooth is searching for the paired device.

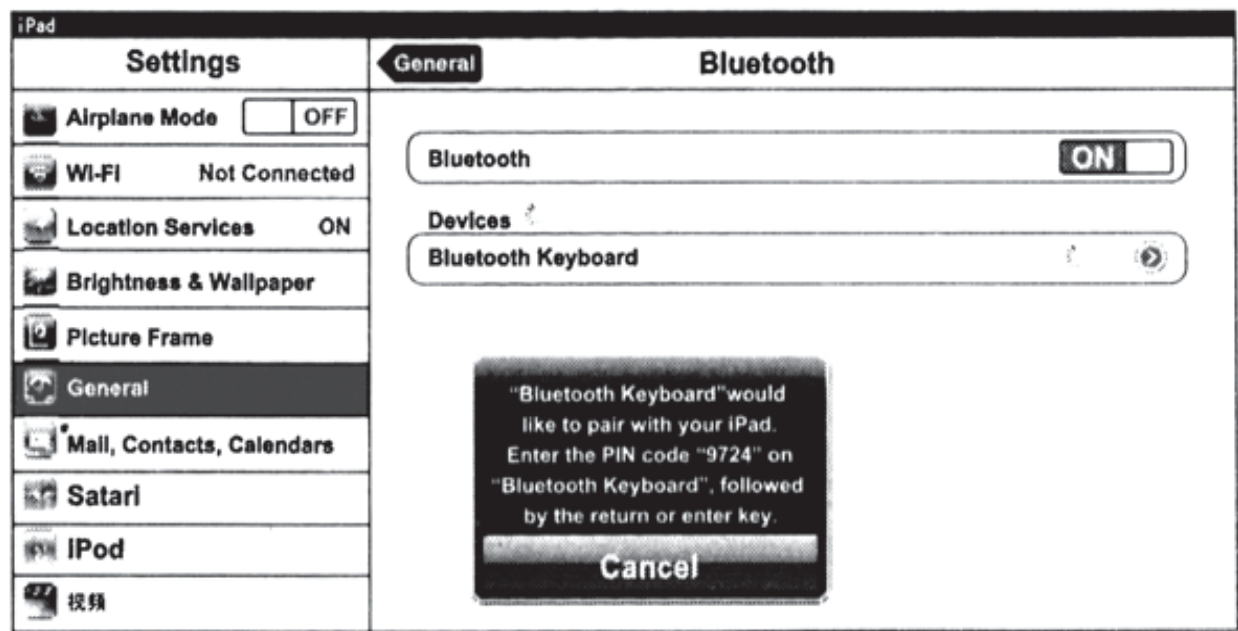


## Connecting to an iPad

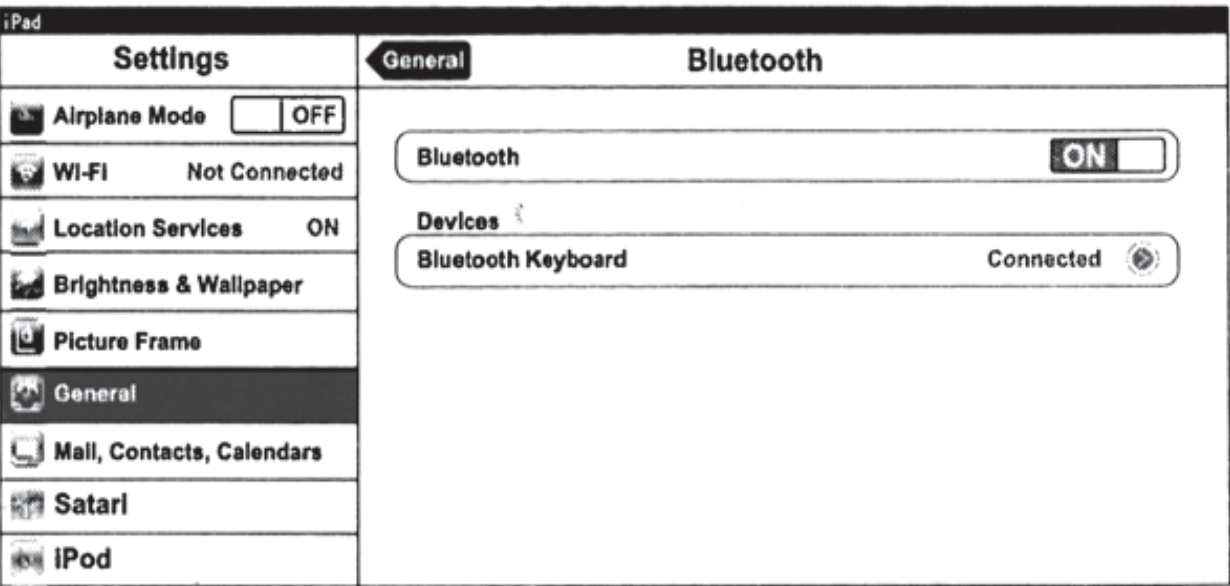
1. Open the 'Settings' app on the iPad.
2. Choose General, then click on the Bluetooth option and turn it 'On'.
3. The iPad will automatically search for the paired device.



- 4. When the device "Bluetooth Keyboard" appears on the screen of the iPad, click it to connect and pair.
- 5. Enter the PIN code displayed on the screen using the keyboard. Each time, a different PIN code will be generated, so there is no need to record it.
- 6. The PIN code will be shown on the iPad or iPhone during the connection process.

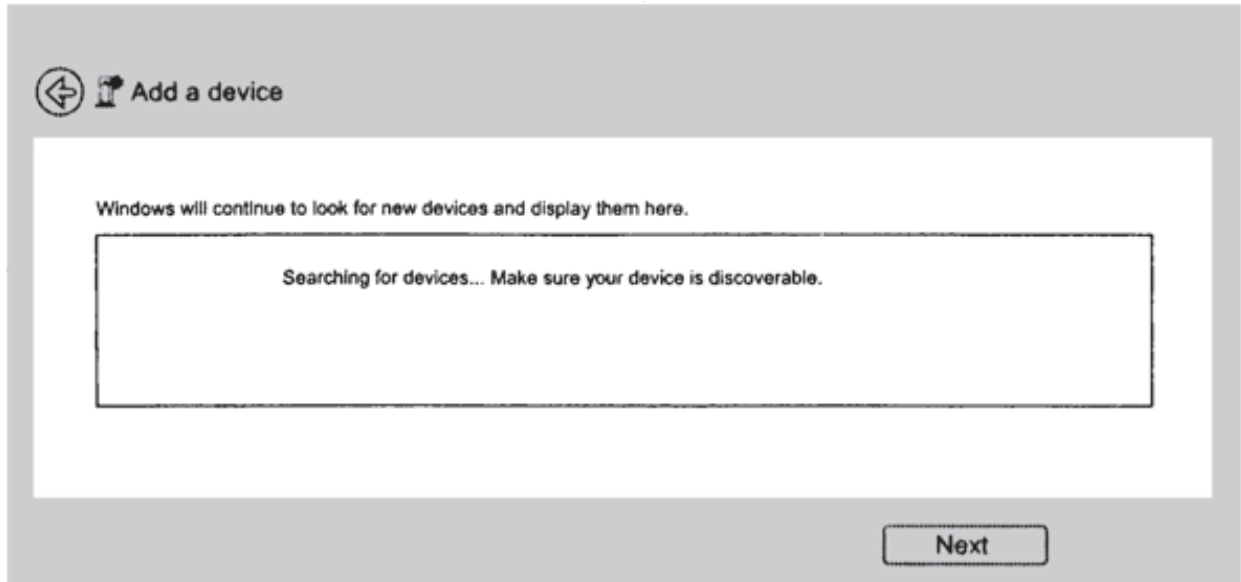


- 7. When you see "Connected" on the iPad, the connection indicator light will turn off.



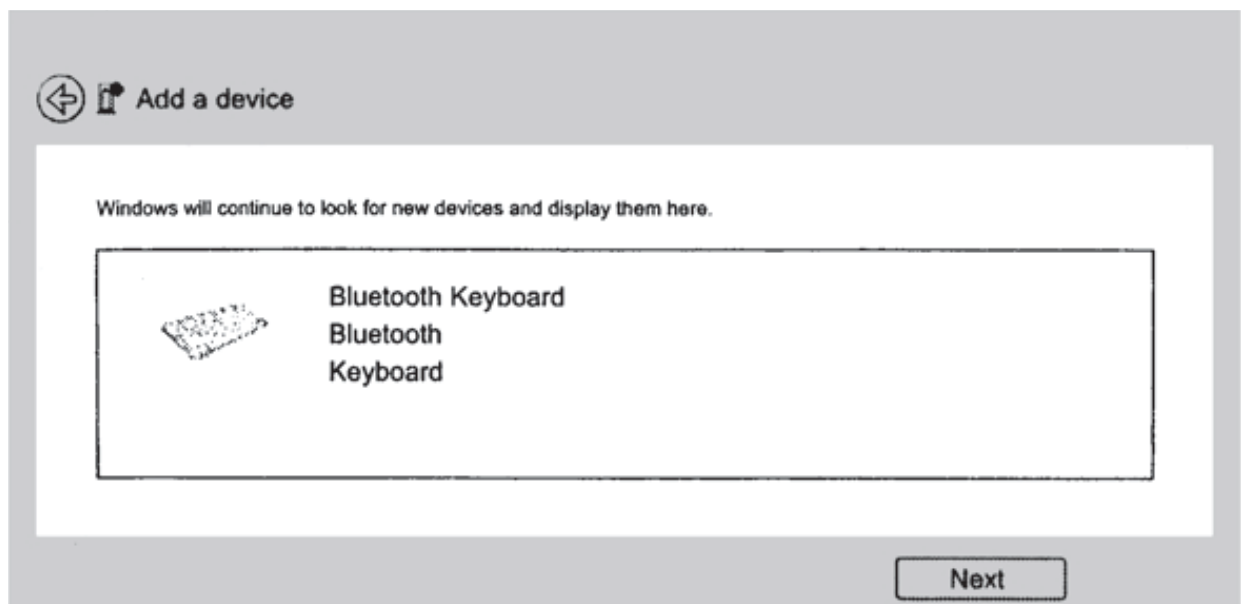
## Connecting to Windows OS Systems

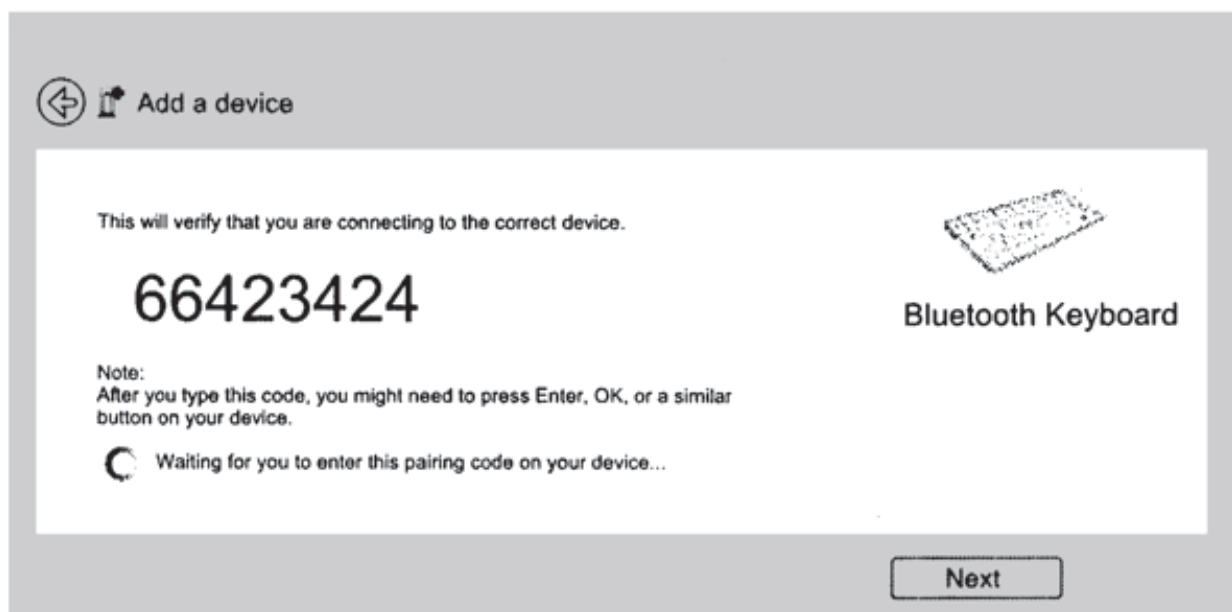
1. Switch on the Bluetooth keyboard.
2. Press the Connect button. The blue LED will flash, indicating that the Bluetooth keyboard is ready to connect and pair with your PC.



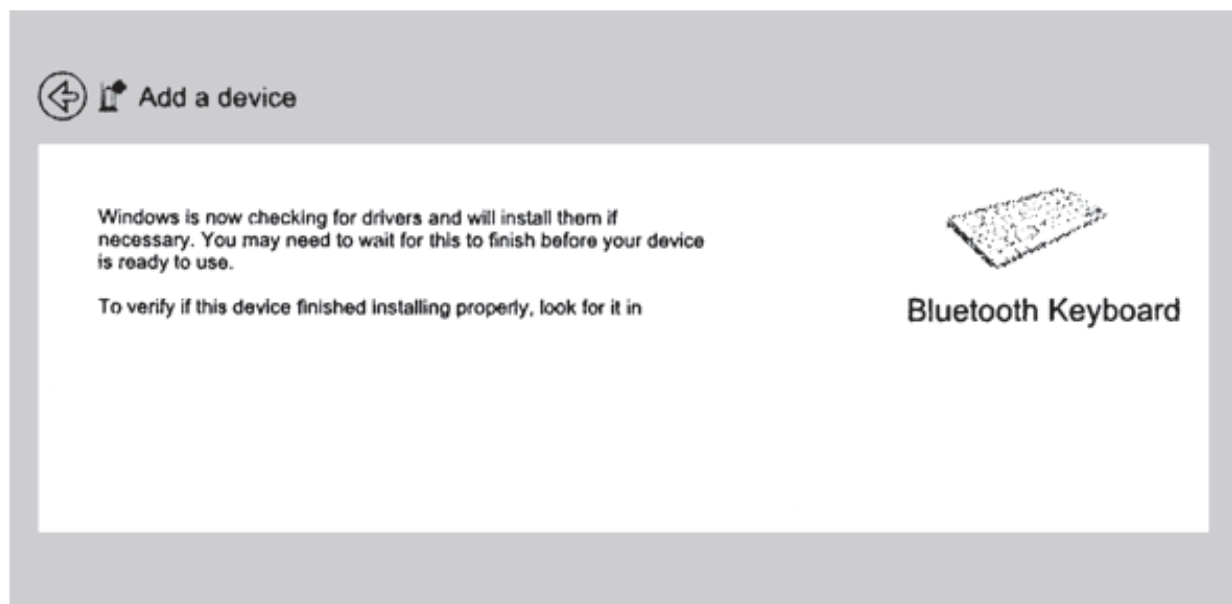
## Connecting to the PC

1. When "Bluetooth Keyboard" appears on the PC screen, click it and select Add.
  2. Enter the PIN code displayed on the PC screen using the Bluetooth keyboard.
- Note:** The PIN code will differ with each connection, so there is no need to record it.





3. When your screen shows "Connecting successfully," the LED light will turn off.

### **Installing the Battery**

1. Use two AAA batteries.
2. Remove the battery cover from the back of the mouse by sliding off the cover while pressing the button at the bottom of the mouse.
3. Insert the batteries, ensuring that the positive (+) and negative (-) ends match the polarity indicators inside the battery housing.
4. Snap the battery cover back into position.
5. Turn on the mouse by sliding the on/off switch at the bottom to the “on” position.

### **Charging the Mouse**

1. Fully drain the power before the first charge.
2. Turn the power switch to the “off” position.
3. Charge with a USB cable by connecting to a power source or computer.
4. The red light will indicate charging.
5. A full charge takes 2 to 2.5 hours.

### **Connecting the Mouse**

1. Open the Bluetooth function on your device (In Bluetooth mode, there is no need to plug the wireless dongle into the computer).
2. When the mouse is in Bluetooth mode, long-press the mode key (6–8 seconds) until the Bluetooth light flashes.
3. Search for this Bluetooth mouse. The Bluetooth name is ‘BT Mouse Porodo’.
4. Click to pair for Bluetooth transmission. Once successfully connected, the Bluetooth mode will be active and functional.



## Notes on Bluetooth Mode

1. Check if your device supports Bluetooth 4.0.
2. Before connecting the mouse, ensure that Bluetooth is enabled on both the mouse and your computer.
3. Ensure the mouse is within a 10m range.
4. If the mouse fails to work after a previous connection, delete the old Bluetooth pairing, then re-pair and reconnect.
5. Check the battery level; if low, recharge the batteries.
6. When the battery is low, the blue light at the bottom of the mouse will start blinking. When the battery is completely drained, the indicator will turn off.
7. If the mouse disconnects or fails to connect and the battery is sufficient, uninstall and reinstall the Bluetooth driver on your computer.

## Disposal
