




- 1. Air Outlet

Instructions for Use

A. Function Button/Gear Adjustment



Speed Setting Roller

Roll the roller up or down to adjust the fan speed, ranging from 1 to 100.

Function Key

Press the button to turn on the fan. In the startup mode, press and hold to activate the cooling function. Press and double-click to enable the lighting function; the screen will not display lighting when this mode is active.

B. Display Status Description




Wind Speed/Electricity Display

The screen shows the wind speed and the battery or charge level.



Cooling Indicator


When the cooling function is activated, the screen will display "CL" and the cooling indicator will light up.



Operation/Status	Display Content
Power On	When the device is powered on, the current wind speed is displayed. When not in use, the screen cycles through power, wind speed, and expression. When cooling is on, it shows wind speed, battery level, cooling indicator ("CL"), and the expression cycle.
Regulating Wind Speed	Displays the current wind speed.
Battery Display	Shows the power level with the power icon lit up in green.
Does not turn on	Press the button, and if the power is 0, the power icon blinks and shrinks, then the display turns off.
Low Battery Reminder	When the battery is low, the battery icon changes from green to red.
Charging	During charging, the current battery level is displayed, and the battery icon lights up in red.
Fully Charged	When fully charged, "100" is displayed, and the battery icon lights up in green.

C. Using the Fan

- 1. Hold the handle to operate the fan.
- 2. Rotate the mask to 100° and place it on a flat surface.



D. Product Cleaning

- 1. Before cleaning the product, ensure that the power supply is disconnected.
- 2. The product mask cannot be removed. Use a clean cloth and brush to wipe the surface of the fan cover and air inlet grid.
- 3. Do not use water or any other liquids to clean electrical components (such as motors, power switches, etc.).
- 4. Avoid touching the power supply or electrical components with wet hands or cloths.
