



# Safety Precautions

**WARNING:** The cutter head can only be washed with water after being detached from the main body of the device.

- 1. Keep the USB power cable dry.
- 2. Before connecting the product, ensure the voltage marked on the power supply matches the product's required voltage. Use only a low-power circuit output adapter that complies with GB 4706.1-2005 standard, with an output voltage not exceeding 5V and an output current not exceeding 1A.
- **3.** Immediately stop using the product if any abnormality or malfunction is detected. Address the issue according to the type of fault, and if necessary, have it repaired by the company's maintenance department.
- 4. Individuals with physical disabilities, mental impairments, or lack of relevant experience and knowledge (including children) must use the product only under the supervision and guidance of a guardian.
- **5.** Only use the provided USB-C power cable to charge this product. If the USB cable is damaged, it must be discarded.
- 6. Do not forcefully pull the USB power cable while charging the product.
- 7. The nose hair cutter head and shaver head are detachable and washable, but do not immerse them in water.
- 8. Do not clean the nose hair trimmer with salt water, thinner, gasoline, alcohol, or other chemicals.
- **9.** When traveling, always attach the protective cap to the nose hair trimmer to safeguard the cutter head.
- 10. The nose hair trimmer may become slightly warm during use or charging; this is normal and safe.
- 11. This nose hair trimmer is designed exclusively for trimming nose and ear hair. Do not attempt to use it for any other purpose.
- **12.** To avoid injury, control the force and depth of use carefully. Do not forcefully push the cutter head into the nostrils or ear canals.
- 13. Do not charge the nose hair trimmer for extended periods.

- **14.** Charge, use, and store the nose hair trimmer between 5°C and 35°C. Do not store it in direct sunlight or near heat sources.
- **15.** Do not disassemble the cutter head assembly during use or after exposure to hot water.

## Usage Instructions

- 1. Press the power button to turn the trimmer on, and press again to turn it off (Figure 1).
- 2. The nose hair trimmer head features a built-in light function for precise trimming, which can be used with a mirror (Figure 2).
- **3.** The nose hair trimmer head is designed specifically for trimming nose hair (Figure 3).
- 4. The shaver head is used for trimming mustaches (Figure 4).

WARNING: Do not use the product if the blade is damaged.



# Travel Lock

- 1. For first-time use: Press and hold the power button for over 3 seconds to unlock and power on.
- 2. When unlocked: Press briefly to turn the device on/off.
- **3.** To activate lock mode: Press and hold for more than 3 seconds; the green indicator will flash 3 times to confirm.
- 4. To unlock: Press and hold for more than 3 seconds to directly unlock and power on.
- **5.** When locked: A brief press causes the indicator to flash 3 times, signaling the lock status.

## Charging

- 1. Press the power button to turn off the nose hair trimmer.
- 2. Insert the USB Type-C plug into the trimmer and connect the other end to a power source.
- 3. Red blinking indicator: Charging in progress.
- 4. After approximately 1 hour: Solid green light indicates full charge.
- 5. A fully charged trimmer provides up to 90 minutes of runtime
- 6. Actual trimming time varies based on trimming habits, maintenance, frequency, and hair type (nose/ear)

## Maintenance and Cleaning

- 1. Before cleaning, press the power button to turn off the nose hair trimmer.
- 2. Rotate the cutter head assembly clockwise to remove it.
- 3. Rinse the cutter head assembly under running water.





**4.** After the cutter head assembly dries completely, align it with the main body and rotate counterclockwise until a click is heard, indicating secure installation.

**Warning:** The cutter head can only be washed with water after being detached from the main body unit.

# Troubleshooting

#### 1. Charging indicator not lit

Possible Cause: Faulty charging indicator Solution: Return for after-sales repair

Possible Cause: Low battery (long-term disuse)

Solution: Continue charging; normal function resumes in ~5 minutes

Possible Cause: Charging circuit failure Solution: Return for after-sales repair

#### 2. Excessive charging time

Possible Cause: Non-original USB cable used Solution: Use the included USB power cable Possible Cause: End of battery lifespan Solution: Return for after-sales repair Possible Cause: Charging circuit failure Solution: Return for after-sales repair

#### 3. No response when powering on

Possible Cause: Insufficient battery charge

Solution: Connect USB cable for charging/wired operation mode

Possible Cause: Power button failure Solution: Return for after-sales repair Possible Cause: Circuit malfunction

Solution: Return for repair; device unusable

#### 4. Failure to charge

Possible Cause: Damaged trimmer/USB cable

Solution: Return for after-sales repair

Possible Cause: Charging temperature too low/high

Solution: Charge in ambient temperatures between 5°C-35°C

#### 5. Skin allergy after use

Possible Cause: Skin adaptation period required

Solution: Symptoms typically disappear after 2-3 weeks of regular use


