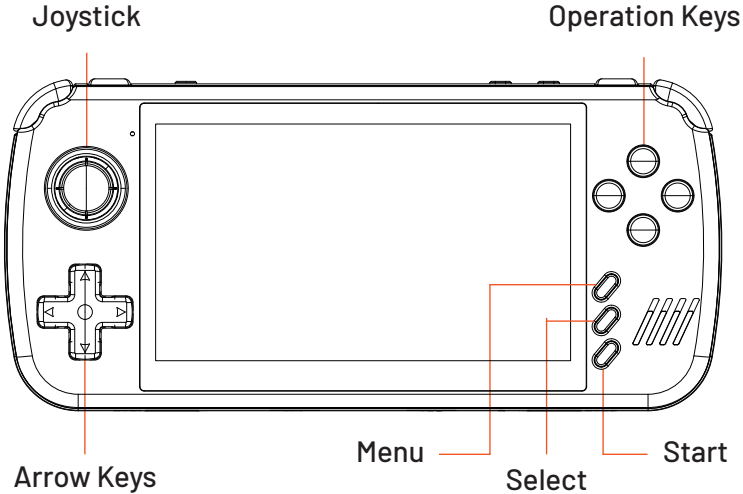
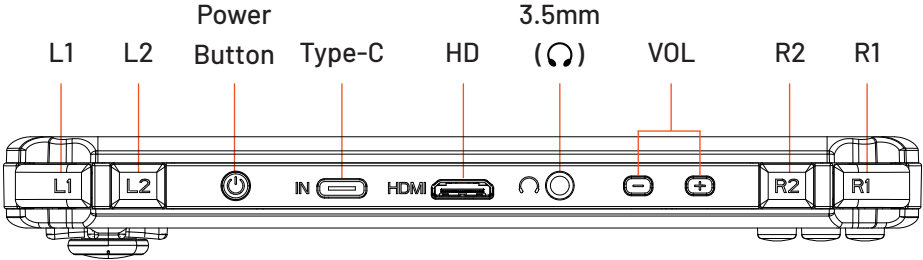

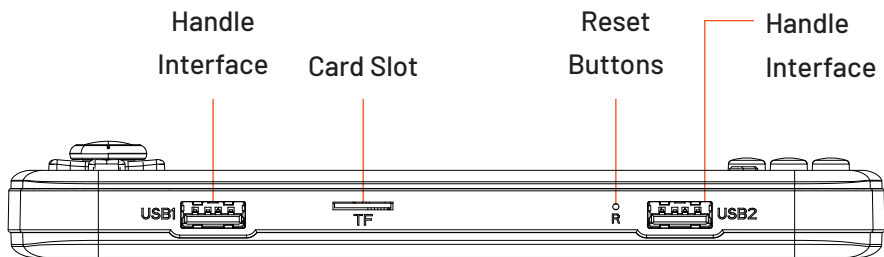
Important Notes

Button Functions

After entering the main interface of the system, refer to the following table for key operation.

A	Confirm Key, Enter the game or start the function to use.
B	Cancel Button
X	Control Characters to punch/shoot/jump, different interface game functions vary.
Y	Control Characters to punch/shoot/jump, different interface game functions vary.
Menu	Used to open the in-game menu.

System Settings Guide

After booting, press the X key to enter the setting interface:

1. **Language Setting:** Go to System Settings> Language. Use the cross key or joystick to change the language, then press the A key to confirm.
2. **Theme Style:** Use the cross key or joystick to modify the style, then press the A button to confirm.
3. **Backlight Setting:** Use the cross key or joystick to adjust the brightness, then press the A key to confirm.
4. **Advanced Settings:** This section shows detailed information such as the machine version and memory size. You can also enable or disable the key tone (open or close).

Game Installation Guide

1. Use your computer to read the TF card and transfer both the game file and the preview file. Ensure the game file has the same name as the preview file.
2. Copy the files to the path: /game in the corresponding simulator or folder.

Product Features

1. The device features a 4.5-inch IPS screen with a resolution of 480×854, providing clear and vibrant visuals.
2. The device can be connected to a TV for a larger display experience.
3. The memory can be expanded using a TF card for additional storage capacity.
4. The device supports wired controllers to enhance gaming control.
5. The device is compatible with a wide range of games, including CPS, FBA, FC, GB, GBA, GBC, NEOGEO, SFC, MD, and PS formats, and allows users to download additional game formats for more options.
6. The game search function enables users to locate games easily by entering the first letter of the title.
7. The instant save function allows users to preserve game progress at any time.

8. The device automatically keeps a record of recently played games for quick access.
9. The standby mode serves as an energy-saving feature to extend playtime.
10. The device allows users to set and access their favorite games quickly.
11. The system offers multilingual support for a more personalized gaming experience.
12. The display settings can be customized, including options for energy-saving modes, brightness, interface background, and more.

Charging Instructions

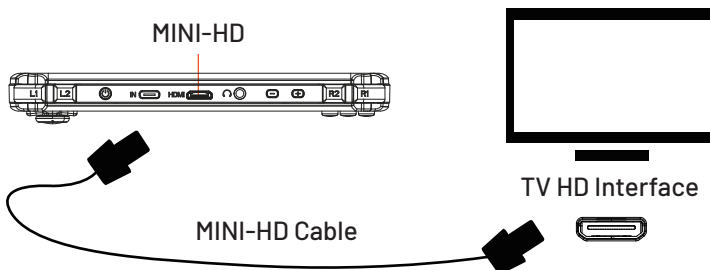
The device is equipped with a 3000mAh rechargeable battery. When the battery level is low, the screen may flicker or sound performance may degrade. Charge the device promptly. Before charging, save your game progress and connect the adapter to begin charging. The recommended charging voltage is 5V.

Note: Do not charge the device for more than four hours continuously.

Video Output Connection

To connect the device to a TV or external display, follow these steps:

1. Plug the MINI-HD cable into the MINI-HD port on the device.
2. Connect the other end of the MINI-HD cable to the TV's HD interface.
3. Your TV should now display the content from the device.



Navigation and Controls

1. Main Interface

1.1 SELECT Button – Set or Remove Favorites

Highlight any game on the main screen and press the SELECT button to add or remove it from your favorites list.

1.2 Type: Enter the game category and use the joystick or arrow keys to choose the emulator type.

1.3 History: View a list of recently played games.

1.4 Search

[A] Enter characters

[B] Hide the keyboard

1.5 Select Confirm characters

[X] select characters

[Y] Delete characters

2. In-Game Menu

Press the menu button while playing to access the following options: Restart the game, Return to the game, Save progress, Load progress, Adjust settings, and Exit the game.

Troubleshooting Guide

1. Game Console Will Not Power On

Check whether the battery is depleted. Connect the USB cable or charger, then attempt to power on the device again.

2. No Sound in Headphones

Verify that the volume is set to an appropriate level. Ensure the headphones are securely connected to the headphone jack.

Disposal
