

Be careful when liquid is poured into the food processor or blender, as hot liquids can be ejected due to sudden steaming.






A. Product Charging and Assembly Charging the Product




B. Steps for Installing Juice Cups




C. Product Usage

Light Display Setting

A. The correspondence between battery level and light display when charging

Battery level	Light display	Remark
Less than 30%	1 Red	When you are charging, the four lights flash counterclockwise
31%-55%	2 White	in sequence. 2. White Pull out TYPE-C
56%-80%	3 White	and press the power switch to confirm the battery level based on
81%-100%	4 White	the number of lights on.

B. Corresponding relationship between battery level and light display when the machine is working

Battery level	Light Display	Remark	
81%-100%	4 White	Keep light	
56%-80%	3 White	Keep light	
31%-55%	2 White	Keep light	
Less than 30%	1 Red	Keep light	
Less than 20%	1 Red	Flicker	

C. Working status and light display instructions

Working mode	Light display	Operation method	
Standby	The switch light and battery light are on. The battery light will turn off for more than 10 seconds without any operation.	Press switch once	
Running	The switch light, battery light, and function light are on.	Press switch once and press function button once	
Pause	The switch light and battery light are on.	Press function button once	
Off	All lights are off.	Press switch once	

D. Protection instructions

Light display	Fault Description	How to solve it
1 light flashes red and enters standby mode	Charging current exceeds the limit	Use a legitimate TYPE-C charger
1 light flashes red and enters standby mode	Discharge current exceeds the limit	Shaking the juice cup or reduce the food
1 light flashes red and enters standby mode. The switch light will turn red and remain on	Motor temperature exceeds the limit or battery temperature exceeds the limit	Cool the machine for more than 30 minutes or blow the machine with a fan for more than 10 minutes
