The speaker supports Bluetooth 5.4, TWS (True Wireless Stereo), hands-free calls, and easy controls. It includes a shoulder strap for easy portability and offers multiple input options, including USB-C and AUX. Battery Life: Rechargeable batteries lose charge cycles over time and may need replacement after a certain number of uses.

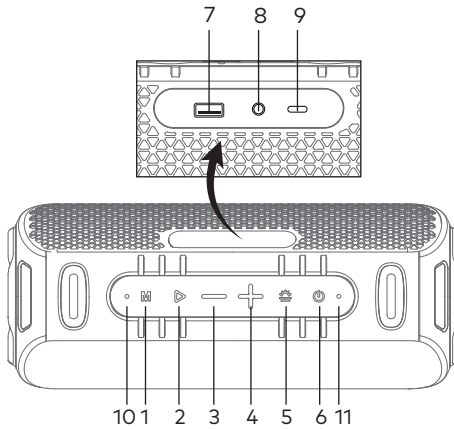

Product Sections

1. Mode button: switch the playing mode.
2. Pause button: play, pause, answer call, TWS.
3. Volume down button - : previous song, decrease the volume.
4. Volume up button + : next song, increase the volume.
5. Turn on/off RGB light.
6. Power button: power on/off.
7. USB port.
8. AUX IN port.
9. Type-C charging port.
10. Bluetooth indicator.
11. Charging indicator.



Setup Guide

1. The Speaker's Battery

Rechargeable Battery: The speaker is powered by a built-in rechargeable battery.

Charging: Use the provided charging cable to connect the speaker to a power source or USB port. The LED indicator turns red while charging and turns off when fully charged.

Battery Maintenance: It's recommended to fully charge the speaker before using it again after a long period of storage.

2. Power ON/OFF

Power On: Press and hold the power button for 2 seconds to turn the speaker on.

Power Off: Press and hold the power button for 8 seconds to turn the speaker off. This will also help reset the speaker if it malfunctions.

3. Connect The Speaker

Bluetooth Pairing: Activate Bluetooth on your device and search for the speaker from the available list.

Audio Cable Connection: You can also connect an external audio device using the provided AUX or USB cable.

TWS Mode: To connect two speakers in TWS mode for stereo sound, follow the instructions to pair both devices wirelessly.

4. Disconnect The Speaker

Bluetooth Disconnection: To disconnect, simply press and hold the mode button for 2 seconds after Bluetooth connection is established.

5. Reconnect The Speaker

Automatic Reconnection: Some devices support automatic reconnection. If you previously paired with the speaker, it will automatically reconnect when turned on. If it does not reconnect, press the power button for 2 seconds to manually reestablish the connection.

6. RGB Light

RGB Mode: Press the RGB button to toggle the LED light between different effects. The lights sync to the rhythm of the music, providing a dynamic visual experience.

7. Playing Mode

Mode Switching: Press the mode button to cycle through various playback modes, such as BT (Bluetooth), AUX, and USB.

8. Audio Cable Connection

Wired Connection: Connect a 3.5mm audio cable from your device to the speaker. The speaker will then switch to audio input from the wired connection.

9. USB Mode

Music Playback via USB: Connect the speaker to your music source via USB to play music.

10. Reset

Factory Reset: If you need to clear the pairing memory, press and hold the reset button for 5 seconds. The speaker will revert to its default settings and will prompt for a new connection.

11. The Pause Button's Functionality

Short Press: Toggles music playback between play and pause.

Long Press: Pauses music and enters TWS (True Wireless Stereo)

mode. Press again for 2 seconds to disconnect TWS.

12. Change Volume And Songs

Volume Control:

Increase: Press the "+" button to raise the volume.

Decrease: Press the "-" button to lower the volume.

Song Navigation:

Previous Song: Press and hold the "-" button.

Next Song: Press and hold the "+" button.

13. Automatic Turn Off Functionality

Power Saving: The speaker will automatically turn off if there's no Bluetooth connection or music is playing for 10 minutes.

Connections

1. TWS Connection

Turn on both speakers.

Press and hold the Play/Pause button on one speaker for 2 seconds until you hear a "beep" sound. The default is the primary speaker, which you operated the Play/Pause button on for pairing.

Release the Play/Pause button. It may take a few seconds for the speakers to connect. Check the indicator lights to distinguish L/R channels: the white light on one speaker flashes while the other shows a solid white light, which should be the primary (left) channel.

Connect to your smartphone by selecting the speaker number in Bluetooth settings (only one number will appear if both speakers are paired).

2. TWS Disconnection

Press and hold the Play/Pause button on one speaker for about 2 seconds until you hear a “beep” sound.

Fault And Maintenance

Connection failed:

Ensure the multifunction indicator light flashes blue or white on your speakers. If not, charge the speaker until the light turns on.

Ensure the speaker and Bluetooth device are within 12-8 meters and there are no obstacles between them.

Check the Bluetooth settings on your device.

Music player sounds distorted:

Ensure the distance between the speakers and the connected device is effective for Bluetooth communication (12-8 meters).

Ensure no obstacles are blocking the Bluetooth signal.

Verify the speaker or playback device isn't in low power mode.

Important Notes

1. Notes Before Use

Place the speaker on a stable surface, avoiding any potential risk of falling or causing personal injury.

Clean the speaker with a dry cloth only. Please power off the speaker and unplug it before cleaning.

The speaker does not turn on?

Recharge your speaker.

The speaker does not turn off or respond?

Reset the speaker by holding the power button for 8 seconds to automatically reset and turn it off.

There is no sound?

Adjust the volume.

Ensure your Bluetooth device is within range.

Make sure there are no obstacles blocking or disturbing the Bluetooth signal.

Check the device's Bluetooth connection to confirm the speaker is connected.

There is poor sound quality?

Move the device closer to the speaker or remove obstacles between them.

Cannot connect the device with the speaker?

Disconnect other connected devices and try again.

You can force a disconnection by moving out of Bluetooth range (10 meters).

Note: To avoid affecting product performance, please charge your device at least once every 3 months.

Disposal
